

19_PSA_048_006 Fear took hold upon them there, [and] pain, as of a woman in travail. #

19_PSA_048_007 Thou breakest the ships of Tarshish with an east wind. #

19_PSA_048_008 As we have heard, so have we seen in the city of the LORD of hosts, in the city of our God, God will establish it for ever. Selah. #

19_PSA_048_009 We have thought of thy lovingkindness, O God, in the midst of thy temple. #

19_PSA_048_010 According to thy name, O God, so [is] thy praise unto the ends of the earth, thy right hand is full of righteousness. #

19_PSA_048_011 Let mount Zion rejoice, let the daughters of Judah be glad, because of thy judgments. #

19_PSA_048_012 Walk about Zion, and go round about her, tell the towers thereof. #

19_PSA_048_013 Mark ye well her bulwarks, consider her palaces; that ye may tell [it] to the generation following. #

19_PSA_048_014 For this God [is] our God for ever and ever, he will be our guide [even] unto death. #

19_PSA_049_001 To the chief Musician, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. Hear this, all [ye] people; give ear, all [ye] inhabitants of the world, #

19_PSA_049_002 Both low and high, rich and poor, together. #

19_PSA_049_003 My mouth shall speak of wisdom; and the meditation of my heart [shall be] of understanding. #

19_PSA_049_004 I will incline mine ear to a parable, I will open my dark saying upon the harp. #

19_PSA_049_005 Wherefore should I fear in the days of evil, [when] the iniquity of my heels shall compass me about? #

19_PSA_049_006 They that trust in their wealth, and boast themselves in the multitude of their riches; #

19_PSA_049_007 None [of them] can by any means redeem his brother, nor give to God a ransom for him, #

19_PSA_049_008 (For the redemption of their soul [is] precious, and it ceaseth for ever_) #

19_PSA_049_009 That he should still live for ever, [and] not see corruption. #

19_PSA_049_010 For he seeth [that] wise men die, likewise the fool and the brutish person perish, and leave their wealth to others. #

19_PSA_049_011 Their inward thought [is, that] their houses [shall continue] for ever, [and] their dwelling places to all generations; they call [their] lands after their

own names. #

19_PSA_049_012 Nevertheless man [being] in honour abideth not, he is like the beasts [that] perish. #

19_PSA_049_013 This their way [is] their folly, yet their posterity approve their sayings. Selah. #

19_PSA_049_014 Like sheep they are laid in the grave; death shall feed on them; and the upright shall have dominion over them in the morning; and their beauty shall consume in the grave from their dwelling. #

19_PSA_049_015 But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave, for he shall receive me. Selah. #

19_PSA_049_016 Be not thou afraid when one is made rich, when the glory of his house is increased; #

19_PSA_049_017 For when he dieth he shall carry nothing away, his glory shall not descend after him. #

19_PSA_049_018 Though while he lived he blessed his soul, and [men] will praise thee, when thou doest well to thyself. #

19_PSA_049_019 He shall go to the generation of his fathers; they shall never see light. #

19_PSA_049_020 Man [that is] in honour, and understandeth not, is like the beasts [that] perish. #

19_PSA_050_001 A Psalm of Asaph. The mighty God, [even] the LORD, hath spoken, and called the earth from the rising of the sun unto the going down thereof. #

19_PSA_050_002 Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God hath shined. #

19_PSA_050_003 Our God shall come, and shall not keep silence, a fire shall devour before him, and it shall be very tempestuous round about him. #

19_PSA_050_004 He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that he may judge his people. #

19_PSA_050_005 Gather my saints together unto me; those that have made a covenant with me by sacrifice. #

19_PSA_050_006 And the heavens shall declare his righteousness, for God [is] judge himself. Selah. #

19_PSA_050_007 Hear, O my people, and I will speak; O Israel, and I will testify against thee, I [am] God, [even] thy God. #

19_PSA_050_008 I will not reprove thee for thy sacrifices or thy burnt offerings, [to have been] continually before me. #

19_PSA_050_009 I will take no bullock out of thy house, [nor] he goats out of thy folds. #

19_PSA_050_010 For every beast of the forest [is] mine, [and] the cattle upon a thousand hills. #

19_PSA_050_011 I know all the fowls of the mountains, and the wild beasts of the field [are] mine. #

19_PSA_050_012 If I were hungry, I would not tell thee, for the world [is] mine, and the fulness thereof. #

19_PSA_050_013 Will I eat the flesh of bulls, or drink the blood of goats? #

19_PSA_050_014 Offer unto God thanksgiving; and pay thy vows unto the most High, #

19_PSA_050_015 And call upon me in the day of trouble, I will deliver thee, and thou shalt glorify me. #

19_PSA_050_016 But unto the wicked God saith, What hast thou to do to declare my statutes, or [that] thou shouldest take my covenant in thy mouth? #

19_PSA_050_017 Seeing thou hatest instruction, and castest my words behind thee. #

19_PSA_050_018 When thou sawest a thief, then thou consentedst with him, and hast been partaker with adulterers. #

19_PSA_050_019 Thou givest thy mouth to evil, and thy tongue frameth deceit. #

19_PSA_050_020 Thou sittest [and] speakest against thy brother; thou slanderest thine own mother's son. #

19_PSA_050_021 These [things] hast thou done, and I kept silence; thou thoughtest that I was altogether [such an one] as thyself, [but] I will reprove thee, and set [them] in order before thine eyes. #

19_PSA_050_022 Now consider this, ye that forget God, lest I tear [you] in pieces, and [there be] none to deliver. #

19_PSA_050_023 Whoso offereth praise glorifieth me, and to him that ordereth [his] conversation [aright] will I show the salvation of God. #

19_PSA_051_001 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness, according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions. #

19_PSA_051_002 Wash me thoroughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. #

19_PSA_051_003 For I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin [is] ever before me. #

19_PSA_051_004 Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done [this] evil in thy sight, that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, [and] be clear when thou judgest. #

19_PSA_051_005 Behold, I was shapen in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me. #

19_PSA_051_006 Behold, thou desirest truth in the inward parts, and in the hidden [part] thou shalt make me to know wisdom. #

19_PSA_051_007 Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean, wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. #

19_PSA_051_008 Make me to hear joy and gladness; [that] the bones [which] thou hast broken may rejoice. #

19_PSA_051_009 Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities. #

19_PSA_051_010 Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. #

19_PSA_051_011 Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy holy spirit from me. #

19_PSA_051_012 Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me [with thy] free spirit. #

19_PSA_051_013 [Then] will I teach transgressors thy ways; and sinners shall be converted unto thee. #

19_PSA_051_014 Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God, thou God of my salvation, [and] my tongue shall sing aloud of thy righteousness. #

19_PSA_051_015 O Lord, open thou my lips; and my mouth shall show forth thy praise. #

19_PSA_051_016 For thou desirest not sacrifice; else would I give [it], thou delightest not in burnt offering. #

19_PSA_051_017 The sacrifices of God [are] a broken spirit, a broken and a contrite heart, O God, thou wilt not despise. #

19_PSA_051_018 Do good in thy good pleasure unto Zion, build thou the walls of Jerusalem. #

19_PSA_051_019 Then shalt thou be pleased with the sacrifices of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering, then shall they offer bullocks upon thine altar. #

19_PSA_052_001 To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually. #

19_PSA_052_002 Thy tongue deviseth mischiefs; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully. #

19_PSA_052_003 Thou lovest evil more than good; [and] lying rather than to speak righteousness. Selah. #

19_PSA_052_004 Thou lovest all devouring words, O [thou] deceitful tongue. #

19_PSA_052_005 God shall likewise destroy thee for ever, he shall take thee away, and pluck thee out of [thy] dwelling place, and root thee out of the land of the living. Selah. #

19_PSA_052_006 The righteous also shall see, and fear, and shall laugh at him, #

19_PSA_052_007 Lo, [this is] the man [that] made not God his strength; but trusted in the abundance of his riches, [and] strengthened himself in his wickedness. #

19_PSA_052_008 But I [am] like a green olive tree in the house of God, I trust in the mercy of God for ever and ever. #

19_PSA_052_009 I will praise thee for ever, because thou hast done [it], and I will wait on thy name; for [it is] good before thy saints. #

19_PSA_053_001 To the chief Musician upon Mahalath, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity, [there is] none that doeth good. #

19_PSA_053_002 God looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were [any] that did understand, that did seek God. #

19_PSA_053_003 Every one of them is gone back, they are altogether become filthy; [there is] none that doeth good, no, not one. #

19_PSA_053_004 Have the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people [as] they eat bread, they have not called upon God. #

19_PSA_053_005 There were they in great fear, [where] no fear was, for God hath scattered the bones of him that encampeth [against] thee, thou hast put [them] to shame, because God hath despised them. #

19_PSA_053_006 Oh that the salvation of Israel [were come] out of Zion! When God bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, [and] Israel shall be glad. #

19_PSA_054_001 To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when the Ziphims came and said to Saul, Doth not David hide himself with us? Save me, O God, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength. #

19_PSA_054_002 Hear my prayer, O God; give ear to the words of my mouth. #

19_PSA_054_003 For strangers are risen up against me, and oppressors seek after my soul, they have not set God before them. Selah. #

19_PSA_054_004 Behold, God [is] mine helper, the Lord [is] with them that uphold my soul. #

19_PSA_054_005 He shall reward evil unto mine enemies, cut them off in thy truth. #

19_PSA_054_006 I will freely sacrifice unto thee, I will praise thy name, O LORD; for [it is] good. #

19_PSA_054_007 For he hath delivered me out of all trouble, and mine eye hath seen [his desire] upon mine enemies. #

19_PSA_055_001 To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. Give ear to my prayer, O God; and hide not thyself from my supplication. #

19_PSA_055_002 Attend unto me, and hear me, I mourn in my complaint, and make a noise; #

19_PSA_055_003 Because of the voice of the enemy, because of the oppression of the wicked, for they cast iniquity upon me, and in wrath they hate me. #

19_PSA_055_004 My heart is sore pained within me, and the terrors of death are fallen upon me. #

19_PSA_055_005 Fearfulness and trembling are come upon me, and horror hath overwhelmed me. #

19_PSA_055_006 And I said, Oh that I had wings like a dove! [for then] would I fly away, and be at rest. #

19_PSA_055_007 Lo, [then] would I wander far off, [and] remain in the wilderness. Selah. #

19_PSA_055_008 I would hasten my escape from the windy storm [and] tempest. #

19_PSA_055_009 Destroy, O Lord, [and] divide their tongues, for I have seen violence and strife in the city. #

19_PSA_055_010 Day and night they go about it upon the walls thereof, mischief also and sorrow [are] in the midst of it. #

19_PSA_055_011 Wickedness [is] in the midst thereof, deceit and guile depart not from her streets. #

19_PSA_055_012 For [it was] not an enemy [that] reproached me; then I could have borne [it], neither [was it] he that hated me [that] did magnify [himself] against me; then I would have hid myself from him, #

19_PSA_055_013 But [it was] thou, a man mine equal, my guide, and mine acquaintance. #

19_PSA_055_014 We took sweet counsel together, [and] walked unto the house of God in company. #

19_PSA_055_015 Let death seize upon them, [and] let them go down quick into hell, for wickedness [is] in their dwellings, [and] among them. #

19_PSA_055_016 As for me, I will call upon God; and the LORD shall save me. #

19_PSA_055_017 Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud, and he shall hear my voice. #

19_PSA_055_018 He hath delivered my soul in peace from the battle [that was] against me, for there were many with me. #

19_PSA_055_019 God shall hear, and afflict them, even he that abideth of old. Selah. Because they have no changes, therefore they fear not God. #

19_PSA_055_020 He hath put forth his hands against such as be at peace with him, he hath broken his covenant. #

19_PSA_055_021 [The words] of his mouth were smoother than butter, but war [was] in his heart, his words were softer than oil, yet [were] they drawn swords. #

19_PSA_055_022 Cast thy burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain thee, he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved. #

19_PSA_055_023 But thou, O God, shalt bring them down into the pit of destruction, bloody and deceitful men shall not live out half their days; but I will trust in thee. #

19_PSA_056_001 To the chief Musician upon Jonathelemrechokim, Michtam of David, when the Philistines took him in Gath. Be merciful unto me, O God, for man would swallow me up; he fighting daily oppresseth me. #

19_PSA_056_002 Mine enemies would daily swallow [me] up, for [they be] many that fight against me, O thou most High. #

19_PSA_056_003 What time I am afraid, I will trust in thee. #

19_PSA_056_004 In God I will praise his word, in God I have put my trust; I will not fear what flesh can do unto me. #

19_PSA_056_005 Every day they wrest my words, all their thoughts [are] against me for evil. #

19_PSA_056_006 They gather themselves together, they hide themselves, they mark my steps, when they wait for my soul. #

19_PSA_056_007 Shall they escape by iniquity? in [thine] anger cast down the people, O God. #

19_PSA_056_008 Thou tellest my wanderings, put thou my tears into thy bottle, [are they] not in thy book? #

19_PSA_056_009 When I cry [unto thee], then shall mine enemies turn back, this I know; for God [is] for me. #

19_PSA_056_010 In **God will I praise [his] word, in the LORD will I praise [his] word.**
#

19_PSA_056_011 In **God have I put my trust, I will not be afraid what man can do unto me.** #

19_PSA_056_012 **Thy vows [are] upon me, O God, I will render praises unto thee.**
#

19_PSA_056_013 **For thou hast delivered my soul from death, [wilt] not [thou deliver] my feet from falling, that I may walk before God in the light of the living?** #

19_PSA_057_001 **To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David, when he fled from Saul in the cave. Be merciful unto me, O God, be merciful unto me, for my soul trusteth in thee, yea, in the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge, until [these] calamities be overpast.** #

19_PSA_057_002 **I will cry unto God most high; unto God that performeth [all things] for me.** #

19_PSA_057_003 **He shall send from heaven, and save me [from] the reproach of him that would swallow me up. Selah. God shall send forth his mercy and his truth.**
#

19_PSA_057_004 **My soul [is] among lions, [and] I lie [even among] them that are set on fire, [even] the sons of men, whose teeth [are] spears and arrows, and their tongue a sharp sword.** #

19_PSA_057_005 **Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens; [let] thy glory [be] above all the earth.** #

19_PSA_057_006 **They have prepared a net for my steps; my soul is bowed down, they have digged a pit before me, into the midst whereof they are fallen [themselves]. Selah.** #

19_PSA_057_007 **My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed, I will sing and give praise.** #

19_PSA_057_008 **Awake up, my glory; awake, psaltery and harp, I [myself] will awake early.** #

19_PSA_057_009 **I will praise thee, O Lord, among the people, I will sing unto thee among the nations.** #

19_PSA_057_010 **For thy mercy [is] great unto the heavens, and thy truth unto the clouds.** #

19_PSA_057_011 **Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens, [let] thy glory [be] above all the earth.** #

19_PSA_058_001 **To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David. Do ye indeed speak righteousness, O congregation? do ye judge uprightly, O ye sons of men?** #

19_PSA_058_002 Yea, in heart ye work wickedness; ye weigh the violence of your hands in the earth. #

19_PSA_058_003 The wicked are estranged from the womb, they go astray as soon as they be born, speaking lies. #

19_PSA_058_004 Their poison [is] like the poison of a serpent, [they are] like the deaf adder [that] stoppeth her ear; #

19_PSA_058_005 Which will not hearken to the voice of charmers, charming never so wisely. #

19_PSA_058_006 Break their teeth, O God, in their mouth, break out the great teeth of the young lions, O LORD. #

19_PSA_058_007 Let them melt away as waters [which] run continually, [when] he bendeth [his bow to shoot] his arrows, let them be as cut in pieces. #

19_PSA_058_008 As a snail [which] melteth, let [every one of them] pass away, [like] the untimely birth of a woman, [that] they may not see the sun. #

19_PSA_058_009 Before your pots can feel the thorns, he shall take them away as with a whirlwind, both living, and in [his] wrath. #

19_PSA_058_010 The righteous shall rejoice when he seeth the vengeance, he shall wash his feet in the blood of the wicked. #

19_PSA_058_011 So that a man shall say, Verily [there is] a reward for the righteous, verily he is a God that judgeth in the earth. #

19_PSA_059_001 To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David; when Saul sent, and they watched the house to kill him. Deliver me from mine enemies, O my God, defend me from them that rise up against me. #

19_PSA_059_002 Deliver me from the workers of iniquity, and save me from bloody men. #

19_PSA_059_003 For, lo, they lie in wait for my soul, the mighty are gathered against me; not [for] my transgression, nor [for] my sin, O LORD. #

19_PSA_059_004 They run and prepare themselves without [my] fault, awake to help me, and behold. #

19_PSA_059_005 Thou therefore, O LORD God of hosts, the God of Israel, awake to visit all the heathen, be not merciful to any wicked transgressors. Selah. #

19_PSA_059_006 They return at evening, they make a noise like a dog, and go round about the city. #

19_PSA_059_007 Behold, they belch out with their mouth, swords [are] in their lips, for who, [say they], doth hear? #

19_PSA_059_008 But thou, O LORD, shalt laugh at them; thou shalt have all the heathen in derision. #

19_PSA_059_009 [Because of] his strength will I wait upon thee, for God [is] my defence. #

19_PSA_059_010 The God of my mercy shall prevent me, God shall let me see [my desire] upon mine enemies. #

19_PSA_059_011 Slay them not, lest my people forget, scatter them by thy power; and bring them down, O Lord our shield. #

19_PSA_059_012 [For] the sin of their mouth [and] the words of their lips let them even be taken in their pride, and for cursing and lying [which] they speak. #

19_PSA_059_013 Consume [them] in wrath, consume [them], that they [may] not [be], and let them know that God ruleth in Jacob unto the ends of the earth. Selah. #

19_PSA_059_014 And at evening let them return; [and] let them make a noise like a dog, and go round about the city. #

19_PSA_059_015 Let them wander up and down for meat, and grudge if they be not satisfied. #

19_PSA_059_016 But I will sing of thy power; yea, I will sing aloud of thy mercy in the morning, for thou hast been my defence and refuge in the day of my trouble. #

19_PSA_059_017 Unto thee, O my strength, will I sing, for God [is] my defence, [and] the God of my mercy. #

19_PSA_060_001 To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Job returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again. #

19_PSA_060_002 Thou hast made the earth to tremble; thou hast broken it, heal the breaches thereof; for it shakeeth. #

19_PSA_060_003 Thou hast showed thy people hard things, thou hast made us to drink the wine of astonishment. #

19_PSA_060_004 Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee, that it may be displayed because of the truth. Selah. #

19_PSA_060_005 That thy beloved may be delivered; save [with] thy right hand, and hear me. #

19_PSA_060_006 God hath spoken in his holiness; I will rejoice, I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth. #

19_PSA_060_007 Gilead [is] mine, and Manasseh [is] mine; Ephraim also [is] the strength of mine head; Judah [is] my lawgiver; #

19_PSA_060_008 Moab [is] my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe, Philistia, triumph thou because of me. #

19_PSA_060_009 Who will bring me [into] the strong city? who will lead me into Edom? #

19_PSA_060_010 [Wilt] not thou, O God, [which] hadst cast us off? and [thou], O God, [which] didst not go out with our armies? #

19_PSA_060_011 Give us help from trouble, for vain [is] the help of man. #

19_PSA_060_012 Through God we shall do valiantly, for he [it is that] shall tread down our enemies. #

19_PSA_061_001 To the chief Musician upon Neginah, [A Psalm] of David. Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer. #

19_PSA_061_002 From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed, lead me to the rock [that] is higher than I. #

19_PSA_061_003 For thou hast been a shelter for me, [and] a strong tower from the enemy. #

19_PSA_061_004 I will abide in thy tabernacle for ever, I will trust in the covert of thy wings. Selah. #

19_PSA_061_005 For thou, O God, hast heard my vows, thou hast given [me] the heritage of those that fear thy name. #

19_PSA_061_006 Thou wilt prolong the king's life, [and] his years as many generations. #

19_PSA_061_007 He shall abide before God for ever, O prepare mercy and truth, [which] may preserve him. #

19_PSA_061_008 So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, that I may daily perform my vows. #

19_PSA_062_001 To the chief Musician, to Jeduthun, A Psalm of David. Truly my soul waiteth upon God, from him [cometh] my salvation. #

19_PSA_062_002 He only [is] my rock and my salvation; [he is] my defence; I shall not be greatly moved. #

19_PSA_062_003 How long will ye imagine mischief against a man? ye shall be slain all of you, as a bowing wall [shall ye be, and as] a tottering fence. #

19_PSA_062_004 They only consult to cast [him] down from his excellency, they delight in lies, they bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly. Selah. #

19_PSA_062_005 My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation [is] from him. #

19_PSA_062_006 He only [is] my rock and my salvation, [he is] my defence; I shall not be moved. #

19_PSA_062_007 In **God** [is] **my salvation and my glory, the rock of my strength,**
[and] **my refuge,** [is] in **God.** #

19_PSA_062_008 Trust in **him at all times;** [ye] **people, pour out your heart before**
him, God [is] a **refuge for us. Selah.** #

19_PSA_062_009 Surely **men of low degree** [are] **vanity,** [and] **men of high degree**
[are] a **lie, to be laid in the balance, they** [are] **altogether** [lighter] **than vanity.** #

19_PSA_062_010 Trust **not in oppression, and become not vain in robbery, if**
riches increase, set not your heart [upon them]. #

19_PSA_062_011 **God hath spoken once; twice have I heard this; that power**
[belongeth] **unto God.** #

19_PSA_062_012 Also **unto thee, O Lord,** [belongeth] **mercy, for thou renderest to**
every man according to his work. #

19_PSA_063_001 A **Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O**
God, thou [art] **my God; early will I seek thee, my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh**
longeth for thee in a **dry and thirsty land, where no water is;** #

19_PSA_063_002 To **see thy power and thy glory,** so [as] I **have seen thee in the**
sanctuary. #

19_PSA_063_003 Because **thy lovingkindness** [is] **better than life, my lips shall**
praise thee. #

19_PSA_063_004 Thus **will I bless thee while I live, I will lift up my hands in thy**
name. #

19_PSA_063_005 My **soul shall be satisfied as** [with] **marrow and fatness; and my**
mouth shall praise [thee] **with joyful lips,** #

19_PSA_063_006 When I **remember thee upon my bed,** [and] **meditate on thee** in
the [night] **watches.** #

19_PSA_063_007 Because **thou hast been my help, therefore in the shadow of thy**
wings will I rejoice. #

19_PSA_063_008 My **soul followeth hard after thee, thy right hand upholdeth me.**
#

19_PSA_063_009 But those [that] **seek my soul, to destroy** [it], **shall go into the**
lower parts of the earth. #

19_PSA_063_010 They **shall fall by the sword, they shall be a portion for foxes.** #

19_PSA_063_011 But the **king shall rejoice in God; every one that sweareth by him**
shall glory, but the mouth of them that speak lies shall be stopped. #

19_PSA_064_001 To the **chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Hear my voice, O God, in**
my prayer, preserve my life from fear of the enemy. #

19_PSA_064_002 Hide me from the secret counsel of the wicked; from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity, #

19_PSA_064_003 Who whet their tongue like a sword, [and] bend [their bows to shoot] their arrows, [even] bitter words, #

19_PSA_064_004 That they may shoot in secret at the perfect, suddenly do they shoot at him, and fear not. #

19_PSA_064_005 They encourage themselves [in] an evil matter, they commune of laying snares privily; they say, Who shall see them? #

19_PSA_064_006 They search out iniquities; they accomplish a diligent search, both the inward [thought] of every one [of them], and the heart, [is] deep. #

19_PSA_064_007 But God shall shoot at them [with] an arrow; suddenly shall they be wounded. #

19_PSA_064_008 So they shall make their own tongue to fall upon themselves, all that see them shall flee away. #

19_PSA_064_009 And all men shall fear, and shall declare the work of God; for they shall wisely consider of his doing. #

19_PSA_064_010 The righteous shall be glad in the LORD, and shall trust in him; and all the upright in heart shall glory. #

19_PSA_065_001 To the chief Musician, A Psalm [and] Song of David. Praise waiteth for thee, O God, in Sion, and unto thee shall the vow be performed. #

19_PSA_065_002 O thou that hearest prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come. #

19_PSA_065_003 Iniquities prevail against me, [as for] our transgressions, thou shalt purge them away. #

19_PSA_065_004 Blessed [is the man whom] thou choosest, and causest to approach [unto thee, that] he may dwell in thy courts, we shall be satisfied with the goodness of thy house, [even] of thy holy temple. #

19_PSA_065_005 [By] terrible things in righteousness wilt thou answer us, O God of our salvation; [who art] the confidence of all the ends of the earth, and of them that are afar off [upon] the sea, #

19_PSA_065_006 Which by his strength setteth fast the mountains; [being] girded with power, #

19_PSA_065_007 Which stilleth the noise of the seas, the noise of their waves, and the tumult of the people. #

19_PSA_065_008 They also that dwell in the uttermost parts are afraid at thy tokens, thou makest the outgoings of the morning and evening to rejoice. #

19_PSA_065_009 Thou visitest the earth, and waterest it, thou greatly enrichest it with the river of God, [which] is full of water, thou preparest them corn, when

thou hast so provided for it. #

19_PSA_065_010 Thou waterest the ridges thereof abundantly, thou settlest the furrows thereof, thou makest it soft with showers, thou blessest the springing thereof. #

19_PSA_065_011 Thou crownest the year with thy goodness; and thy paths drop fatness. #

19_PSA_065_012 They drop [upon] the pastures of the wilderness, and the little hills rejoice on every side. #

19_PSA_065_013 The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for joy, they also sing. #

19_PSA_066_001 To the chief Musician, A Song [or] Psalm. Make a joyful noise unto God, all ye lands, #

19_PSA_066_002 Sing forth the honour of his name, make his praise glorious. #

19_PSA_066_003 Say unto God, How terrible [art thou in] thy works! through the greatness of thy power shall thine enemies submit themselves unto thee. #

19_PSA_066_004 All the earth shall worship thee, and shall sing unto thee; they shall sing [to] thy name. Selah. #

19_PSA_066_005 Come and see the works of God, [he is] terrible [in his] doing toward the children of men. #

19_PSA_066_006 He turned the sea into dry [land], they went through the flood on foot, there did we rejoice in him. #

19_PSA_066_007 He ruleth by his power for ever; his eyes behold the nations, let not the rebellious exalt themselves. Selah. #

19_PSA_066_008 O bless our God, ye people, and make the voice of his praise to be heard, #

19_PSA_066_009 Which holdeth our soul in life, and suffereth not our feet to be moved. #

19_PSA_066_010 For thou, O God, hast proved us, thou hast tried us, as silver is tried. #

19_PSA_066_011 Thou broughtest us into the net; thou laidst affliction upon our loins. #

19_PSA_066_012 Thou hast caused men to ride over our heads; we went through fire and through water, but thou broughtest us out into a wealthy [place]. #

19_PSA_066_013 I will go into thy house with burnt offerings, I will pay thee my vows, #

19_PSA_066_014 Which my lips have uttered, and my mouth hath spoken, when I was in trouble. #

19_PSA_066_015 I will offer unto thee burnt sacrifices of fatlings, with the incense of rams; I will offer bullocks with goats. Selah. #

19_PSA_066_016 Come [and] hear, all ye that fear God, and I will declare what he hath done for my soul. #

19_PSA_066_017 I cried unto him with my mouth, and he was extolled with my tongue. #

19_PSA_066_018 If I regard iniquity in my heart, the Lord will not hear [me], #

19_PSA_066_019 [But] verily God hath heard [me]; he hath attended to the voice of my prayer. #

19_PSA_066_020 Blessed [be] God, which hath not turned away my prayer, nor his mercy from me. #

19_PSA_067_001 To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm [or] Song. God be merciful unto us, and bless us; [and] cause his face to shine upon us; Selah. #

19_PSA_067_002 That thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving health among all nations. #

19_PSA_067_003 Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee. #

19_PSA_067_004 O let the nations be glad and sing for joy, for thou shalt judge the people righteously, and govern the nations upon earth. Selah. #

19_PSA_067_005 Let the people praise thee, O God; let all the people praise thee. #

19_PSA_067_006 [Then] shall the earth yield her increase; [and] God, [even] our own God, shall bless us. #

19_PSA_067_007 God shall bless us; and all the ends of the earth shall fear him. #

19_PSA_068_001 To the chief Musician, A Psalm [or] Song of David. Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered, let them also that hate him flee before him. #

19_PSA_068_002 As smoke is driven away, [so] drive [them] away, as wax melteth before the fire, [so] let the wicked perish at the presence of God. #

19_PSA_068_003 But let the righteous be glad; let them rejoice before God, yea, let them exceedingly rejoice. #

19_PSA_068_004 Sing unto God, sing praises to his name, extol him that rideth upon the heavens by his name JAH, and rejoice before him. #

19_PSA_068_005 A father of the fatherless, and a judge of the widows, [is] God in his holy habitation. #

19_PSA_068_006 God setteth the solitary in families, he bringeth out those which are bound with chains, but the rebellious dwell in a dry [land]. #

19_PSA_068_007 O God, when thou wentest forth before thy people, when thou didst march through the wilderness; Selah, #

19_PSA_068_008 The earth shook, the heavens also dropped at the presence of God, [even] Sinai itself [was moved] at the presence of God, the God of Israel. #

19_PSA_068_009 Thou, O God, didst send a plentiful rain, whereby thou didst confirm thine inheritance, when it was weary. #

19_PSA_068_010 Thy congregation hath dwelt therein, thou, O God, hast prepared of thy goodness for the poor. #

19_PSA_068_011 The Lord gave the word, great [was] the company of those that published [it]. #

19_PSA_068_012 Kings of armies did flee apace, and she that tarried at home divided the spoil. #

19_PSA_068_013 Though ye have lien among the pots, [yet shall ye be as] the wings of a dove covered with silver, and her feathers with yellow gold. #

19_PSA_068_014 When the Almighty scattered kings in it, it was [white] as snow in Salmon. #

19_PSA_068_015 The hill of God [is as] the hill of Bashan; an high hill [as] the hill of Bashan. #

19_PSA_068_016 Why leap ye, ye high hills? [this is] the hill [which] God desireth to dwell in; yea, the LORD will dwell [in it] for ever. #

19_PSA_068_017 The chariots of God [are] twenty thousand, [even] thousands of angels, the Lord [is] among them, [as in] Sinai, in the holy [place]. #

19_PSA_068_018 Thou hast ascended on high, thou hast led captivity captive, thou hast received gifts for men; yea, [for] the rebellious also, that the LORD God might dwell [among them]. #

19_PSA_068_019 Blessed [be] the Lord, [who] daily loadeth us [with benefits,even] the God of our salvation. Selah. #

19_PSA_068_020 [He that is] our God [is] the God of salvation; and unto GOD the Lord [belong] the issues from death. #

19_PSA_068_021 But God shall wound the head of his enemies, [and] the hairy scalp of such an one as goeth on still in his trespasses. #

19_PSA_068_022 The Lord said, I will bring again from Bashan, I will bring [my people] again from the depths of the sea, #

19_PSA_068_023 That thy foot may be dipped in the blood of [thine] enemies, [and] the tongue of thy dogs in the same. #

19_PSA_068_024 They have seen thy goings, O God; [even] the goings of my God, my King, in the sanctuary. #

19_PSA_068_025 The singers went before, the players on instruments [followed] after; among [them were] the damsels playing with timbrels. #

19_PSA_068_026 Bless ye God in the congregations, [even] the Lord, from the fountain of Israel. #

19_PSA_068_027 There [is] little Benjamin [with] their ruler, the princes of Judah [and] their council, the princes of Zebulun, [and] the princes of Naphtali. #

19_PSA_068_028 Thy God hath commanded thy strength, strengthen, O God, that which thou hast wrought for us. #

19_PSA_068_029 Because of thy temple at Jerusalem shall kings bring presents unto thee. #

19_PSA_068_030 Rebuke the company of spearmen, the multitude of the bulls, with the calves of the people, [till every one] submit himself with pieces of silver, scatter thou the people [that] delight in war. #

19_PSA_068_031 Princes shall come out of Egypt; Ethiopia shall soon stretch out her hands unto God. #

19_PSA_068_032 Sing unto God, ye kingdoms of the earth; O sing praises unto the Lord; Selah, #

19_PSA_068_033 To him that rideth upon the heavens of heavens, [which were] of old; lo, he doth send out his voice, [and that] a mighty voice. #

19_PSA_068_034 Ascribe ye strength unto God, his excellency [is] over Israel, and his strength [is] in the clouds. #

19_PSA_068_035 O God, [thou art] terrible out of thy holy places, the God of Israel [is] he that giveth strength and power unto [his] people. Blessed [be] God. #

19_PSA_069_001 To the chief Musician upon Shoshannim, [A Psalm] of David. Save me, O God; for the waters are come in unto [my] soul. #

19_PSA_069_002 I sink in deep mire, where [there is] no standing, I am come into deep waters, where the floods overflow me. #

19_PSA_069_003 I am weary of my crying, my throat is dried, mine eyes fail while I wait for my God. #

19_PSA_069_004 They that hate me without a cause are more than the hairs of mine head, they that would destroy me, [being] mine enemies wrongfully, are mighty, then I restored [that] which I took not away. #

19_PSA_069_005 O God, thou knowest my foolishness; and my sins are not hid from thee. #

19_PSA_069_006 Let not them that wait on thee, O Lord GOD of hosts, be ashamed for my sake, let not those that seek thee be confounded for my sake, O God of Israel. #

19_PSA_069_007 Because for thy sake I have borne reproach; shame hath covered my face. #

19_PSA_069_008 I am become a stranger unto my brethren, and an alien unto my mother's children. #

19_PSA_069_009 For the zeal of thine house hath eaten me up; and the reproaches of them that reproached thee are fallen upon me. #

19_PSA_069_010 When I wept, [and chastened] my soul with fasting, that was to my reproach. #

19_PSA_069_011 I made sackcloth also my garment; and I became a proverb to them. #

19_PSA_069_012 They that sit in the gate speak against me; and I [was] the song of the drunkards. #

19_PSA_069_013 But as for me, my prayer [is] unto thee, O LORD, [in] an acceptable time, O God, in the multitude of thy mercy hear me, in the truth of thy salvation. #

19_PSA_069_014 Deliver me out of the mire, and let me not sink, let me be delivered from them that hate me, and out of the deep waters. #

19_PSA_069_015 Let not the waterflood overflow me, neither let the deep swallow me up, and let not the pit shut her mouth upon me. #

19_PSA_069_016 Hear me, O LORD; for thy lovingkindness [is] good, turn unto me according to the multitude of thy tender mercies. #

19_PSA_069_017 And hide not thy face from thy servant; for I am in trouble, hear me speedily. #

19_PSA_069_018 Draw nigh unto my soul, [and] redeem it, deliver me because of mine enemies. #

19_PSA_069_019 Thou hast known my reproach, and my shame, and my dishonour, mine adversaries [are] all before thee. #

19_PSA_069_020 Reproach hath broken my heart; and I am full of heaviness, and I looked [for some] to take pity, but [there was] none; and for comforters, but I found none. #

19_PSA_069_021 They gave me also gall for my meat; and in my thirst they gave me vinegar to drink. #

19_PSA_069_022 Let their table become a snare before them, and [that which should have been] for [their] welfare, [let it become] a trap. #

19_PSA_069_023 Let their eyes be darkened, that they see not; and make their loins continually to shake. #

19_PSA_069_024 Pour out thine indignation upon them, and let thy wrathful anger take hold of them. #

19_PSA_069_025 Let their habitation be desolate; [and] let none dwell in their tents. #

19_PSA_069_026 For they persecute [him] whom thou hast smitten; and they talk to the grief of those whom thou hast wounded. #

19_PSA_069_027 Add iniquity unto their iniquity, and let them not come into thy righteousness. #

19_PSA_069_028 Let them be blotted out of the book of the living, and not be written with the righteous. #

19_PSA_069_029 But I [am] poor and sorrowful, let thy salvation, O God, set me up on high. #

19_PSA_069_030 I will praise the name of God with a song, and will magnify him with thanksgiving. #

19_PSA_069_031 [This] also shall please the LORD better than an ox [or] bullock that hath horns and hoofs. #

19_PSA_069_032 The humble shall see [this, and] be glad, and your heart shall live that seek God. #

19_PSA_069_033 For the LORD heareth the poor, and despiseth not his prisoners. #

19_PSA_069_034 Let the heaven and earth praise him, the seas, and every thing that moveth therein. #

19_PSA_069_035 For God will save Zion, and will build the cities of Judah, that they may dwell there, and have it in possession. #

19_PSA_069_036 The seed also of his servants shall inherit it, and they that love his name shall dwell therein. #

19_PSA_070_001 To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David, to bring to remembrance. [Make haste], O God, to deliver me; make haste to help me, O LORD. #

19_PSA_070_002 Let them be ashamed and confounded that seek after my soul, let them be turned backward, and put to confusion, that desire my hurt. #

19_PSA_070_003 Let them be turned back for a reward of their shame that say, Aha, aha. #

19_PSA_070_004 Let all those that seek thee rejoice and be glad in thee, and let such as love thy salvation say continually, Let God be magnified. #

19_PSA_070_005 But I [am] poor and needy, make haste unto me, O God, thou [art] my help and my deliverer; O LORD, make no tarrying. #

19_PSA_071_001 In thee, O LORD, do I put my trust, let me never be put to confusion. #

19_PSA_071_002 Deliver me in thy righteousness, and cause me to escape, incline thine ear unto me, and save me. #

19_PSA_071_003 Be thou my strong habitation, whereunto I may continually resort, thou hast given commandment to save me; for thou [art] my rock and my fortress. #

19_PSA_071_004 Deliver me, O my God, out of the hand of the wicked, out of the hand of the unrighteous and cruel man. #

19_PSA_071_005 For thou [art] my hope, O Lord GOD, [thou art] my trust from my youth. #

19_PSA_071_006 By thee have I been holden up from the womb, thou art he that took me out of my mother's bowels, my praise [shall be] continually of thee. #

19_PSA_071_007 I am as a wonder unto many; but thou [art] my strong refuge. #

19_PSA_071_008 Let my mouth be filled [with] thy praise [and with] thy honour all the day. #

19_PSA_071_009 Cast me not off in the time of old age; forsake me not when my strength faileth. #

19_PSA_071_010 For mine enemies speak against me; and they that lay wait for my soul take counsel together, #

19_PSA_071_011 Saying, God hath forsaken him, persecute and take him; for [there is] none to deliver [him]. #

19_PSA_071_012 O God, be not far from me, O my God, make haste for my help. #

19_PSA_071_013 Let them be confounded [and] consumed that are adversaries to my soul; let them be covered [with] reproach and dishonour that seek my hurt. #

19_PSA_071_014 But I will hope continually, and will yet praise thee more and more. #

19_PSA_071_015 My mouth shall show forth thy righteousness [and] thy salvation all the day; for I know not the numbers [thereof]. #

19_PSA_071_016 I will go in the strength of the Lord GOD, I will make mention of thy righteousness, [even] of thine only. #

19_PSA_071_017 O God, thou hast taught me from my youth, and hitherto have I declared thy wondrous works. #

19_PSA_071_018 Now also when I am old and greyheaded, O God, forsake me not; until I have showed thy strength unto [this] generation, [and] thy power to every one [that] is to come. #

19_PSA_071_019 Thy righteousness also, O God, [is] very high, who hast done great things, O God, who [is] like unto thee! #

19_PSA_071_020 [Thou], which hast showed me great and sore troubles, shalt quicken me again, and shalt bring me up again from the depths of the earth. #

19_PSA_071_021 Thou shalt increase my greatness, and comfort me on every side. #

19_PSA_071_022 I will also praise thee with the psaltery, [even] thy truth, O my God, unto thee will I sing with the harp, O thou Holy One of Israel. #

19_PSA_071_023 My lips shall greatly rejoice when I sing unto thee; and my soul, which thou hast redeemed. #

19_PSA_071_024 My tongue also shall talk of thy righteousness all the day long, for they are confounded, for they are brought unto shame, that seek my hurt. #

19_PSA_072_001 [A Psalm] for Solomon. Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son. #

19_PSA_072_002 He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment. #

19_PSA_072_003 The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness. #

19_PSA_072_004 He shall judge the poor of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the oppressor. #

19_PSA_072_005 They shall fear thee as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations. #

19_PSA_072_006 He shall come down like rain upon the mown grass, as showers [that] water the earth. #

19_PSA_072_007 In his days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of peace so long as the moon endureth. #

19_PSA_072_008 He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth. #

19_PSA_072_009 They that dwell in the wilderness shall bow before him; and his enemies shall lick the dust. #

19_PSA_072_010 The kings of Tarshish and of the isles shall bring presents, the kings of Sheba and Seba shall offer gifts. #

19_PSA_072_011 Yea, all kings shall fall down before him, all nations shall serve him. #

19_PSA_072_012 For he shall deliver the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and [him] that hath no helper. #

19_PSA_072_013 He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy. #

19_PSA_072_014 He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence, and precious shall their blood be in his sight. #

19_PSA_072_015 And he shall live, and to him shall be given of the gold of Sheba, prayer also shall be made for him continually; [and] daily shall he be praised. #

19_PSA_072_016 There shall be an handful of corn in the earth upon the top of the mountains; the fruit thereof shall shake like Lebanon, and [they] of the city shall flourish like grass of the earth. #

19_PSA_072_017 His name shall endure for ever, his name shall be continued as long as the sun, and [men] shall be blessed in him, all nations shall call him blessed. #

19_PSA_072_018 Blessed [be] the LORD God, the God of Israel, who only doeth wondrous things. #

19_PSA_072_019 And blessed [be] his glorious name for ever, and let the whole earth be filled [with] his glory; Amen, and Amen. #

19_PSA_072_020 The prayers of David the son of Jesse are ended. #

19_PSA_073_001 A Psalm of Asaph. Truly God [is] good to Israel, [even] to such as are of a clean heart. #

19_PSA_073_002 But as for me, my feet were almost gone; my steps had well nigh slipped. #

19_PSA_073_003 For I was envious at the foolish, [when] I saw the prosperity of the wicked. #

19_PSA_073_004 For [there are] no bands in their death, but their strength [is] firm. #

19_PSA_073_005 They [are] not in trouble [as other] men; neither are they plagued like [other] men. #

19_PSA_073_006 Therefore pride compasseth them about as a chain; violence covereth them [as] a garment. #

19_PSA_073_007 Their eyes stand out with fatness, they have more than heart could wish. #

19_PSA_073_008 They are corrupt, and speak wickedly [concerning] oppression, they speak loftily. #

19_PSA_073_009 They set their mouth against the heavens, and their tongue walketh through the earth. #

19_PSA_073_010 Therefore his people return hither, and waters of a full [cup] are wrung out to them. #

19_PSA_073_011 And they say, How doth God know? and is there knowledge in the most High? #

19_PSA_073_012 Behold, these [are] the ungodly, who prosper in the world; they increase [in] riches. #

19_PSA_073_013 Verily I have cleansed my heart [in] vain, and washed my hands in innocency. #

19_PSA_073_014 For all the day long have I been plagued, and chastened every morning. #

19_PSA_073_015 If I say, I will speak thus; behold, I should offend [against] the generation of thy children. #

19_PSA_073_016 When I thought to know this, it [was] too painful for me; #

19_PSA_073_017 Until I went into the sanctuary of God; [then] understood I their end. #

19_PSA_073_018 Surely thou didst set them in slippery places, thou castedst them down into destruction. #

19_PSA_073_019 How are they [brought] into desolation, as in a moment! they are utterly consumed with terrors. #

19_PSA_073_020 As a dream when [one] awaketh; [so], O Lord, when thou awakest, thou shalt despise their image. #

19_PSA_073_021 Thus my heart was grieved, and I was pricked in my reins. #

19_PSA_073_022 So foolish [was] I, and ignorant, I was [as] a beast before thee. #

19_PSA_073_023 Nevertheless I [am] continually with thee, thou hast holden [me] by my right hand. #

19_PSA_073_024 Thou shalt guide me with thy counsel, and afterward receive me [to] glory. #

19_PSA_073_025 Whom have I in heaven [but thee]? and [there is] none upon earth [that] I desire beside thee. #

19_PSA_073_026 My flesh and my heart faileth, [but] God [is] the strength of my heart, and my portion for ever. #

19_PSA_073_027 For, lo, they that are far from thee shall perish, thou hast destroyed all them that go a whoring from thee. #

19_PSA_073_028 But [it is] good for me to draw near to God, I have put my trust in the Lord GOD, that I may declare all thy works. #

19_PSA_074_001 Maschil of Asaph. O God, why hast thou cast [us] off for ever? [why] doth thine anger smoke against the sheep of thy pasture? #

19_PSA_074_002 Remember thy congregation, [which] thou hast purchased of old; the rod of thine inheritance, [which] thou hast redeemed; this mount Zion,

wherein thou hast dwelt. #

19_PSA_074_003 Lift up thy feet unto the perpetual desolations; [even] all [that] the enemy hath done wickedly in the sanctuary. #

19_PSA_074_004 Thine enemies roar in the midst of thy congregations; they set up their ensigns [for] signs. #

19_PSA_074_005 [A man] was famous according as he had lifted up axes upon the thick trees. #

19_PSA_074_006 But now they break down the carved work thereof at once with axes and hammers. #

19_PSA_074_007 They have cast fire into thy sanctuary, they have defiled [by casting down] the dwelling place of thy name to the ground. #

19_PSA_074_008 They said in their hearts, Let us destroy them together, they have burned up all the synagogues of God in the land. #

19_PSA_074_009 We see not our signs, [there is] no more any prophet, neither [is there] among us any that knoweth how long. #

19_PSA_074_010 O God, how long shall the adversary reproach? shall the enemy blaspheme thy name for ever? #

19_PSA_074_011 Why withdrawest thou thy hand, even thy right hand? pluck [it] out of thy bosom. #

19_PSA_074_012 For God [is] my King of old, working salvation in the midst of the earth. #

19_PSA_074_013 Thou didst divide the sea by thy strength, thou brakest the heads of the dragons in the waters. #

19_PSA_074_014 Thou brakest the heads of leviathan in pieces, [and] gavest him [to be] meat to the people inhabiting the wilderness. #

19_PSA_074_015 Thou didst cleave the fountain and the flood, thou driedst up mighty rivers. #

19_PSA_074_016 The day [is] thine, the night also [is] thine, thou hast prepared the light and the sun. #

19_PSA_074_017 Thou hast set all the borders of the earth, thou hast made summer and winter. #

19_PSA_074_018 Remember this, [that] the enemy hath reproached, O LORD, and [that] the foolish people have blasphemed thy name. #

19_PSA_074_019 O deliver not the soul of thy turtledove unto the multitude [of the wicked], forget not the congregation of thy poor for ever. #

19_PSA_074_020 Have respect unto the covenant, for the dark places of the earth are full of the habitations of cruelty. #

19_PSA_074_021 O let not the oppressed return ashamed, let the poor and needy praise thy name. #

19_PSA_074_022 Arise, O God, plead thine own cause, remember how the foolish man reproacheth thee daily. #

19_PSA_074_023 Forget not the voice of thine enemies, the tumult of those that rise up against thee increaseth continually. #

19_PSA_075_001 To the chief Musician, Altaschith, A Psalm [or] Song of Asaph. Unto thee, O God, do we give thanks, [unto thee] do we give thanks, for [that] thy name is near thy wondrous works declare. #

19_PSA_075_002 When I shall receive the congregation I will judge uprightly. #

19_PSA_075_003 The earth and all the inhabitants thereof are dissolved, I bear up the pillars of it. Selah. #

19_PSA_075_004 I said unto the fools, Deal not foolishly, and to the wicked, Lift not up the horn, #

19_PSA_075_005 Lift not up your horn on high, speak [not with] a stiff neck. #

19_PSA_075_006 For promotion [cometh] neither from the east, nor from the west, nor from the south. #

19_PSA_075_007 But God [is] the judge, he putteth down one, and setteth up another. #

19_PSA_075_008 For in the hand of the LORD [there is] a cup, and the wine is red; it is full of mixture; and he poureth out of the same, but the dregs thereof, all the wicked of the earth shall wring [them] out, [and] drink [them]. #

19_PSA_075_009 But I will declare for ever; I will sing praises to the God of Jacob. #

19_PSA_075_010 All the horns of the wicked also will I cut off; [but] the horns of the righteous shall be exalted. #

19_PSA_076_001 To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm [or] Song of Asaph. In Judah [is] God known, his name [is] great in Israel. #

19_PSA_076_002 In Salem also is his tabernacle, and his dwelling place in Zion. #

19_PSA_076_003 There brake he the arrows of the bow, the shield, and the sword, and the battle. Selah. #

19_PSA_076_004 Thou [art] more glorious [and] excellent than the mountains of prey. #

19_PSA_076_005 The stouthearted are spoiled, they have slept their sleep, and none of the men of might have found their hands. #

19_PSA_076_006 At thy rebuke, O God of Jacob, both the chariot and horse are cast into a dead sleep. #

19_PSA_076_007 Thou, [even] thou, [art] to be feared, and who may stand in thy sight when once thou art angry? #

19_PSA_076_008 Thou didst cause judgment to be heard from heaven; the earth feared, and was still, #

19_PSA_076_009 When God arose to judgment, to save all the meek of the earth. Selah. #

19_PSA_076_010 Surely the wrath of man shall praise thee, the remainder of wrath shalt thou restrain. #

19_PSA_076_011 Vow, and pay unto the LORD your God, let all that be round about him bring presents unto him that ought to be feared. #

19_PSA_076_012 He shall cut off the spirit of princes, [he is] terrible to the kings of the earth. #

19_PSA_077_001 To the chief Musician, to Jeduthun, A Psalm of Asaph. I cried unto God with my voice, [even] unto God with my voice; and he gave ear unto me. #

19_PSA_077_002 In the day of my trouble I sought the Lord, my sore ran in the night, and ceased not, my soul refused to be comforted. #

19_PSA_077_003 I remembered God, and was troubled, I complained, and my spirit was overwhelmed. Selah. #

19_PSA_077_004 Thou holdest mine eyes waking, I am so troubled that I cannot speak. #

19_PSA_077_005 I have considered the days of old, the years of ancient times. #

19_PSA_077_006 I call to remembrance my song in the night, I commune with mine own heart, and my spirit made diligent search. #

19_PSA_077_007 Will the Lord cast off for ever? and will he be favourable no more? #

19_PSA_077_008 Is his mercy clean gone for ever? doth [his] promise fail for evermore? #

19_PSA_077_009 Hath God forgotten to be gracious? hath he in anger shut up his tender mercies? Selah. #

19_PSA_077_010 And I said, This [is] my infirmity, [but I will remember] the years of the right hand of the most High. #

19_PSA_077_011 I will remember the works of the LORD, surely I will remember thy wonders of old. #

19_PSA_077_012 I will meditate also of all thy work, and talk of thy doings. #

19_PSA_077_013 Thy way, O God, [is] in the sanctuary, who [is so] great a God as [our] God? #

19_PSA_077_014 Thou [art] the God that doest wonders, thou hast declared thy strength among the people. #

19_PSA_077_015 Thou hast with [thine] arm redeemed thy people, the sons of Jacob and Joseph. Selah. #

19_PSA_077_016 The waters saw thee, O God, the waters saw thee; they were afraid, the depths also were troubled. #

19_PSA_077_017 The clouds poured out water, the skies sent out a sound, thine arrows also went abroad. #

19_PSA_077_018 The voice of thy thunder [was] in the heaven, the lightnings lightened the world, the earth trembled and shook. #

19_PSA_077_019 Thy way [is] in the sea, and thy path in the great waters, and thy footsteps are not known. #

19_PSA_077_020 Thou leddest thy people like a flock by the hand of Moses and Aaron. #

19_PSA_078_001 Maschil of Asaph. Give ear, O my people, [to] my law, incline your ears to the words of my mouth. #

19_PSA_078_002 I will open my mouth in a parable, I will utter dark sayings of old, #

19_PSA_078_003 Which we have heard and known, and our fathers have told us. #

19_PSA_078_004 We will not hide [them] from their children, showing to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and his strength, and his wonderful works that he hath done. #

19_PSA_078_005 For he established a testimony in Jacob, and appointed a law in Israel, which he commanded our fathers, that they should make them known to their children, #

19_PSA_078_006 That the generation to come might know [them, even] the children [which] should be born; [who] should arise and declare [them] to their children, #

19_PSA_078_007 That they might set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments, #

19_PSA_078_008 And might not be as their fathers, a stubborn and rebellious generation; a generation [that] set not their heart aright, and whose spirit was not steadfast with God. #

19_PSA_078_009 The children of Ephraim, [being] armed, [and] carrying bows, turned back in the day of battle. #

19_PSA_078_010 They kept not the covenant of God, and refused to walk in his law; #

19_PSA_078_011 And forgat his works, and his wonders that he had showed them. #

19_PSA_078_012 Marvellous things did he in the sight of their fathers, in the land of Egypt, [in] the field of Zoan. #

19_PSA_078_013 He divided the sea, and caused them to pass through; and he made the waters to stand as an heap. #

19_PSA_078_014 In the daytime also he led them with a cloud, and all the night with a light of fire. #

19_PSA_078_015 He clave the rocks in the wilderness, and gave [them] drink as [out of] the great depths. #

19_PSA_078_016 He brought streams also out of the rock, and caused waters to run down like rivers. #

19_PSA_078_017 And they sinned yet more against him by provoking the most High in the wilderness. #

19_PSA_078_018 And they tempted God in their heart by asking meat for their lust. #

19_PSA_078_019 Yea, they spake against God; they said, Can God furnish a table in the wilderness? #

19_PSA_078_020 Behold, he smote the rock, that the waters gushed out, and the streams overflowed; can he give bread also? can he provide flesh for his people? #

19_PSA_078_021 Therefore the LORD heard [this], and was wroth, so a fire was kindled against Jacob, and anger also came up against Israel; #

19_PSA_078_022 Because they believed not in God, and trusted not in his salvation, #

19_PSA_078_023 Though he had commanded the clouds from above, and opened the doors of heaven, #

19_PSA_078_024 And had rained down manna upon them to eat, and had given them of the corn of heaven. #

19_PSA_078_025 Man did eat angels' food, he sent them meat to the full. #

19_PSA_078_026 He caused an east wind to blow in the heaven, and by his power he brought in the south wind. #

19_PSA_078_027 He rained flesh also upon them as dust, and feathered fowls like as the sand of the sea, #

19_PSA_078_028 And he let [it] fall in the midst of their camp, round about their habitations. #

19_PSA_078_029 So they did eat, and were well filled, for he gave them their own desire; #

19_PSA_078_030 They were not estranged from their lust. But while their meat [was] yet in their mouths, #

19_PSA_078_031 The wrath of God came upon them, and slew the fattest of them, and smote down the chosen [men] of Israel. #

19_PSA_078_032 For all this they sinned still, and believed not for his wondrous works. #

19_PSA_078_033 Therefore their days did he consume in vanity, and their years in trouble. #

19_PSA_078_034 When he slew them, then they sought him, and they returned and inquired early after God. #

19_PSA_078_035 And they remembered that God [was] their rock, and the high God their redeemer. #

19_PSA_078_036 Nevertheless they did flatter him with their mouth, and they lied unto him with their tongues. #

19_PSA_078_037 For their heart was not right with him, neither were they stedfast in his covenant. #

19_PSA_078_038 But he, [being] full of compassion, forgave [their] iniquity, and destroyed [them] not, yea, many a time turned he his anger away, and did not stir up all his wrath. #

19_PSA_078_039 For he remembered that they [were but] flesh; a wind that passeth away, and cometh not again. #

19_PSA_078_040 How oft did they provoke him in the wilderness, [and] grieve him in the desert! #

19_PSA_078_041 Yea, they turned back and tempted God, and limited the Holy One of Israel. #

19_PSA_078_042 They remembered not his hand, [nor] the day when he delivered them from the enemy. #

19_PSA_078_043 How he had wrought his signs in Egypt, and his wonders in the field of Zoan, #

19_PSA_078_044 And had turned their rivers into blood; and their floods, that they could not drink. #

19_PSA_078_045 He sent divers sorts of flies among them, which devoured them; and frogs, which destroyed them. #

19_PSA_078_046 He gave also their increase unto the caterpillar, and their labour unto the locust. #

19_PSA_078_047 He destroyed their vines with hail, and their sycamore trees with frost. #

19_PSA_078_048 He gave up their cattle also to the hail, and their flocks to hot thunderbolts. #

19_PSA_078_049 He cast upon them the fierceness of his anger, wrath, and indignation, and trouble, by sending evil angels [among them]. #

19_PSA_078_050 He made a way to his anger; he spared not their soul from death, but gave their life over to the pestilence; #

19_PSA_078_051 And smote all the firstborn in Egypt; the chief of [their] strength in the tabernacles of Ham, #

19_PSA_078_052 But made his own people to go forth like sheep, and guided them in the wilderness like a flock. #

19_PSA_078_053 And he led them on safely, so that they feared not, but the sea overwhelmed their enemies. #

19_PSA_078_054 And he brought them to the border of his sanctuary, [even to] this mountain, [which] his right hand had purchased. #

19_PSA_078_055 He cast out the heathen also before them, and divided them an inheritance by line, and made the tribes of Israel to dwell in their tents. #

19_PSA_078_056 Yet they tempted and provoked the most high God, and kept not his testimonies, #

19_PSA_078_057 But turned back, and dealt unfaithfully like their fathers, they were turned aside like a deceitful bow. #

19_PSA_078_058 For they provoked him to anger with their high places, and moved him to jealousy with their graven images. #

19_PSA_078_059 When God heard [this], he was wroth, and greatly abhorred Israel, #

19_PSA_078_060 So that he forsook the tabernacle of Shiloh, the tent [which] he placed among men; #

19_PSA_078_061 And delivered his strength into captivity, and his glory into the enemy's hand. #

19_PSA_078_062 He gave his people over also unto the sword; and was wroth with his inheritance. #

19_PSA_078_063 The fire consumed their young men; and their maidens were not given to marriage. #

19_PSA_078_064 Their priests fell by the sword; and their widows made no lamentation. #

19_PSA_078_065 Then the Lord awaked as one out of sleep, [and] like a mighty man that shouteth by reason of wine. #

19_PSA_078_066 And he smote his enemies in the hinder parts, he put them to a perpetual reproach. #

19_PSA_078_067 Moreover he refused the tabernacle of Joseph, and chose not the tribe of Ephraim, #

19_PSA_078_068 But chose the tribe of Judah, the mount Zion which he loved. #

19_PSA_078_069 And he built his sanctuary like high [palaces], like the earth which he hath established for ever. #

19_PSA_078_070 He chose David also his servant, and took him from the sheepfolds, #

19_PSA_078_071 From following the ewes great with young he brought him to feed Jacob his people, and Israel his inheritance. #

19_PSA_078_072 So he fed them according to the integrity of his heart; and guided them by the skilfulness of his hands. #

19_PSA_079_001 A Psalm of Asaph. O God, the heathen are come into thine inheritance; thy holy temple have they defiled; they have laid Jerusalem on heaps. #

19_PSA_079_002 The dead bodies of thy servants have they given [to be] meat unto the fowls of the heaven, the flesh of thy saints unto the beasts of the earth. #

19_PSA_079_003 Their blood have they shed like water round about Jerusalem; and [there was] none to bury [them]. #

19_PSA_079_004 We are become a reproach to our neighbours, a scorn and derision to them that are round about us. #

19_PSA_079_005 How long, LORD? wilt thou be angry for ever? shall thy jealousy burn like fire? #

19_PSA_079_006 Pour out thy wrath upon the heathen that have not known thee, and upon the kingdoms that have not called upon thy name. #

19_PSA_079_007 For they have devoured Jacob, and laid waste his dwelling place. #

19_PSA_079_008 O remember not against us former iniquities, let thy tender mercies speedily prevent us, for we are brought very low. #

19_PSA_079_009 Help us, O God of our salvation, for the glory of thy name, and deliver us, and purge away our sins, for thy name's sake. #

19_PSA_079_010 Wherefore should the heathen say, Where [is] their God? let him be known among the heathen in our sight [by] the revenging of the blood of thy servants [which is] shed. #

19_PSA_079_011 Let the sighing of the prisoner come before thee; according to the greatness of thy power preserve thou those that are appointed to die; #

19_PSA_079_012 And render unto our neighbours sevenfold into their bosom their reproach, wherewith they have reproached thee, O Lord. #

19_PSA_079_013 So we thy people and sheep of thy pasture will give thee thanks for ever, we will show forth thy praise to all generations. #

19_PSA_080_001 To the chief Musician upon Shoshannimeduth, A Psalm of Asaph. Give ear, O Shepherd of Israel, thou that ledest Joseph like a flock; thou that dwellest [between] the cherubims, shine forth. #

19_PSA_080_002 Before Ephraim and Benjamin and Manasseh stir up thy strength, and come [and] save us. #

19_PSA_080_003 Turn us again, O God, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved. #

19_PSA_080_004 O LORD God of hosts, how long wilt thou be angry against the prayer of thy people? #

19_PSA_080_005 Thou feedest them with the bread of tears; and givest them tears to drink in great measure. #

19_PSA_080_006 Thou makest us a strife unto our neighbours, and our enemies laugh among themselves. #

19_PSA_080_007 Turn us again, O God of hosts, and cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved. #

19_PSA_080_008 Thou hast brought a vine out of Egypt, thou hast cast out the heathen, and planted it. #

19_PSA_080_009 Thou preparedst [room] before it, and didst cause it to take deep root, and it filled the land. #

19_PSA_080_010 The hills were covered with the shadow of it, and the boughs thereof [were like] the goodly cedars. #

19_PSA_080_011 She sent out her boughs unto the sea, and her branches unto the river. #

19_PSA_080_012 Why hast thou [then] broken down her hedges, so that all they which pass by the way do pluck her? #

19_PSA_080_013 The boar out of the wood doth waste it, and the wild beast of the field doth devour it. #

19_PSA_080_014 Return, we beseech thee, O God of hosts, look down from heaven, and behold, and visit this vine; #

19_PSA_080_015 And the vineyard which thy right hand hath planted, and the branch [that] thou madest strong for thyself. #

19_PSA_080_016 [It is] burned with fire, [it is] cut down, they perish at the rebuke of thy countenance. #

19_PSA_080_017 Let thy hand be upon the man of thy right hand, upon the son of man [whom] thou madest strong for thyself. #

19_PSA_080_018 So will not we go back from thee, quicken us, and we will call upon thy name. #

19_PSA_080_019 Turn us again, O LORD God of hosts, cause thy face to shine; and we shall be saved. #

19_PSA_081_001 To the chief Musician upon Gittith, [A Psalm] of Asaph. Sing aloud unto God our strength, make a joyful noise unto the God of Jacob. #

19_PSA_081_002 Take a psalm, and bring hither the timbrel, the pleasant harp with the psaltery. #

19_PSA_081_003 Blow up the trumpet in the new moon, in the time appointed, on our solemn feast day. #

19_PSA_081_004 For this [was] a statute for Israel, [and] a law of the God of Jacob. #

19_PSA_081_005 This he ordained in Joseph [for] a testimony, when he went out through the land of Egypt, [where] I heard a language [that] I understood not. #

19_PSA_081_006 I removed his shoulder from the burden, his hands were delivered from the pots. #

19_PSA_081_007 Thou calledst in trouble, and I delivered thee; I answered thee in the secret place of thunder, I proved thee at the waters of Meribah. Selah. #

19_PSA_081_008 Hear, O my people, and I will testify unto thee, O Israel, if thou wilt hearken unto me; #

19_PSA_081_009 There shall no strange god be in thee; neither shalt thou worship any strange god. #

19_PSA_081_010 I [am] the LORD thy God, which brought thee out of the land of Egypt, open thy mouth wide, and I will fill it. #

19_PSA_081_011 But my people would not hearken to my voice; and Israel would none of me. #

19_PSA_081_012 So I gave them up unto their own hearts' lust, [and] they walked in their own counsels. #

19_PSA_081_013 Oh that my people had hearkened unto me, [and] Israel had walked in my ways! #

19_PSA_081_014 I should soon have subdued their enemies, and turned my hand against their adversaries. #

19_PSA_081_015 The haters of the LORD should have submitted themselves unto him, but their time should have endured for ever. #

19_PSA_081_016 He should have fed them also with the finest of the wheat, and with honey out of the rock should I have satisfied thee. #

19_PSA_082_001 A Psalm of Asaph. God standeth in the congregation of the mighty; he judgeth among the gods. #

19_PSA_082_002 How long will ye judge unjustly, and accept the persons of the wicked? Selah. #

19_PSA_082_003 Defend the poor and fatherless, do justice to the afflicted and needy. #

19_PSA_082_004 Deliver the poor and needy, rid [them] out of the hand of the wicked. #

19_PSA_082_005 They know not, neither will they understand; they walk on in darkness, all the foundations of the earth are out of course. #

19_PSA_082_006 I have said, Ye [are] gods; and all of you [are] children of the most High. #

19_PSA_082_007 But ye shall die like men, and fall like one of the princes. #

19_PSA_082_008 Arise, O God, judge the earth, for thou shalt inherit all nations. #

19_PSA_083_001 A Song [or] Psalm of Asaph. Keep not thou silence, O God, hold not thy peace, and be not still, O God. #

19_PSA_083_002 For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult, and they that hate thee have lifted up the head. #

19_PSA_083_003 They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones. #

19_PSA_083_004 They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from [being] a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance. #

19_PSA_083_005 For they have consulted together with one consent, they are confederate against thee, #

19_PSA_083_006 The tabernacles of Edom, and the Ishmaelites; of Moab, and the Hagarenes; #

19_PSA_083_007 Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of Tyre; #

19_PSA_083_008 Assur also is joined with them, they have holpen the children of Lot. Selah. #

19_PSA_083_009 Do unto them as [unto] the Midianites; as [to] Sisera, as [to] Jabin, at the brook of Kison, #

19_PSA_083_010 [Which] perished at Endor, they became [as] dung for the earth. #

19_PSA_083_011 Make their nobles like Oreb, and like Zeeb, yea, all their princes as Zebah, and as Zalmunna, #

19_PSA_083_012 Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of God in possession. #

19_PSA_083_013 O my God, make them like a wheel; as the stubble before the wind. #

19_PSA_083_014 As the fire burneth a wood, and as the flame setteth the mountains on fire; #

19_PSA_083_015 So persecute them with thy tempest, and make them afraid with thy storm. #

19_PSA_083_016 Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek thy name, O LORD. #

19_PSA_083_017 Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yea, let them be put to shame, and perish, #

19_PSA_083_018 That [men] may know that thou, whose name alone [is] JEHOVAH, [art] the most high over all the earth. #

19_PSA_084_001 To the chief Musician upon Gittith, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. How amiable [are] thy tabernacles, O LORD of hosts! #

19_PSA_084_002 My soul longeth, yea, even fainteth for the courts of the LORD, my heart and my flesh crieth out for the living God. #

19_PSA_084_003 Yea, the sparrow hath found an house, and the swallow a nest for herself, where she may lay her young, [even] thine altars, O LORD of hosts, my King, and my God. #

19_PSA_084_004 Blessed [are] they that dwell in thy house, they will be still praising thee. Selah. #

19_PSA_084_005 Blessed [is] the man whose strength [is] in thee; in whose heart [are] the ways [of them]. #

19_PSA_084_006 [Who] passing through the valley of Baca make it a well; the rain also filleth the pools. #

19_PSA_084_007 They go from strength to strength, [every one of them] in Zion appeareth before God. #

**19_PSA_084_008 O LORD God of hosts, hear my prayer, give ear, O God of Jacob.
Selah. #**

**19_PSA_084_009 Behold, O God our shield, and look upon the face of thine
anointed. #**

**19_PSA_084_010 For a day in thy courts [is] better than a thousand. I had rather be
a doorkeeper in the house of my God, than to dwell in the tents of wickedness. #**

**19_PSA_084_011 For the LORD God [is] a sun and shield, the LORD will give grace
and glory, no good [thing] will he withhold from them that walk uprightly. #**

19_PSA_084_012 O LORD of hosts, blessed [is] the man that trusteth in thee. #

**19_PSA_085_001 To the chief Musician, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. LORD, thou
has been favourable unto thy land, thou hast brought back the captivity of Jacob.
#**

**19_PSA_085_002 Thou hast forgiven the iniquity of thy people, thou hast covered
all their sin. Selah. #**

**19_PSA_085_003 Thou hast taken away all thy wrath, thou hast turned [thyself]
from the fierceness of thine anger. #**

**19_PSA_085_004 Turn us, O God of our salvation, and cause thine anger toward us
to cease. #**

**19_PSA_085_005 Wilt thou be angry with us for ever? wilt thou draw out thine
anger to all generations? #**

**19_PSA_085_006 Wilt thou not revive us again, that thy people may rejoice in
thee? #**

19_PSA_085_007 Show us thy mercy, O LORD, and grant us thy salvation. #

**19_PSA_085_008 I will hear what God the LORD will speak, for he will speak peace
unto his people, and to his saints, but let them not turn again to folly. #**

**19_PSA_085_009 Surely his salvation [is] nigh them that fear him; that glory may
dwell in our land. #**

**19_PSA_085_010 Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace
have kissed [each other]. #**

**19_PSA_085_011 Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look
down from heaven. #**

**19_PSA_085_012 Yea, the LORD shall give [that which is] good; and our land shall
yield her increase. #**

**19_PSA_085_013 Righteousness shall go before him; and shall set [us] in the way
of his steps. #**

**19_PSA_086_001 A Prayer of David. Bow down thine ear, O LORD, hear me, for I
[am] poor and needy. #**

19_PSA_086_002 Preserve my soul; for I [am] holy, O thou my God, save thy servant that trusteth in thee. #

19_PSA_086_003 Be merciful unto me, O Lord, for I cry unto thee daily. #

19_PSA_086_004 Rejoice the soul of thy servant, for unto thee, O Lord, do I lift up my soul. #

19_PSA_086_005 For thou, Lord, [art] good, and ready to forgive; and plenteous in mercy unto all them that call upon thee. #

19_PSA_086_006 Give ear, O LORD, unto my prayer; and attend to the voice of my supplications. #

19_PSA_086_007 In the day of my trouble I will call upon thee, for thou wilt answer me. #

19_PSA_086_008 Among the gods [there is] none like unto thee, O Lord; neither [are there any works] like unto thy works. #

19_PSA_086_009 All nations whom thou hast made shall come and worship before thee, O Lord; and shall glorify thy name. #

19_PSA_086_010 For thou [art] great, and doest wondrous things, thou [art] God alone. #

19_PSA_086_011 Teach me thy way, O LORD; I will walk in thy truth, unite my heart to fear thy name. #

19_PSA_086_012 I will praise thee, O Lord my God, with all my heart, and I will glorify thy name for evermore. #

19_PSA_086_013 For great [is] thy mercy toward me, and thou hast delivered my soul from the lowest hell. #

19_PSA_086_014 O God, the proud are risen against me, and the assemblies of violent [men] have sought after my soul; and have not set thee before them. #

19_PSA_086_015 But thou, O Lord, [art] a God full of compassion, and gracious, longsuffering, and plenteous in mercy and truth. #

19_PSA_086_016 O turn unto me, and have mercy upon me; give thy strength unto thy servant, and save the son of thine handmaid. #

19_PSA_086_017 Show me a token for good; that they which hate me may see [it], and be ashamed, because thou, LORD, hast holpen me, and comforted me. #

19_PSA_087_001 A Psalm [or] Song for the sons of Korah. His foundation [is] in the holy mountains. #

19_PSA_087_002 The LORD loveth the gates of Zion more than all the dwellings of Jacob. #

19_PSA_087_003 Glorious things are spoken of thee, O city of God. selah. #

19_PSA_087_004 I will make mention of Rahab and Babylon to them that know me, behold Philistia, and Tyre, with Ethiopia; this [man] was born there. #

19_PSA_087_005 And of Zion it shall be said, This and that man was born in her, and the highest himself shall establish her. #

19_PSA_087_006 The LORD shall count, when he writeth up the people, [that] this [man] was born there. Selah. #

19_PSA_087_007 As well the singers as the players on instruments [shall be there], all my springs [are] in thee. #

19_PSA_088_001 A Song [or] Psalm for the sons of Korah, to the chief Musician upon Mahalath Leannoth, Maschil of Heman the Ezrahite. O LORD God of my salvation, I have cried day [and] night before thee, #

19_PSA_088_002 Let my prayer come before thee, incline thine ear unto my cry; #

19_PSA_088_003 For my soul is full of troubles, and my life draweth nigh unto the grave. #

19_PSA_088_004 I am counted with them that go down into the pit, I am as a man [that hath] no strength, #

19_PSA_088_005 Free among the dead, like the slain that lie in the grave, whom thou rememberest no more, and they are cut off from thy hand. #

19_PSA_088_006 Thou hast laid me in the lowest pit, in darkness, in the deeps. #

19_PSA_088_007 Thy wrath lieth hard upon me, and thou hast afflicted [me] with all thy waves. Selah. #

19_PSA_088_008 Thou hast put away mine acquaintance far from me; thou hast made me an abomination unto them, [I am] shut up, and I cannot come forth. #

19_PSA_088_009 Mine eye mourneth by reason of affliction, LORD, I have called daily upon thee, I have stretched out my hands unto thee. #

19_PSA_088_010 Wilt thou show wonders to the dead? shall the dead arise [and] praise thee? Selah. #

19_PSA_088_011 Shall thy lovingkindness be declared in the grave? [or] thy faithfulness in destruction? #

19_PSA_088_012 Shall thy wonders be known in the dark? and thy righteousness in the land of forgetfulness? #

19_PSA_088_013 But unto thee have I cried, O LORD; and in the morning shall my prayer prevent thee. #

19_PSA_088_014 LORD, why castest thou off my soul? [why] hidest thou thy face from me? #

19_PSA_088_015 I [am] afflicted and ready to die from [my] youth up, [while] I suffer thy terrors I am distracted. #

19_PSA_088_016 Thy fierce wrath goeth over me; thy terrors have cut me off. #

19_PSA_088_017 They came round about me daily like water; they compassed me about together. #

19_PSA_088_018 Lover and friend hast thou put far from me, [and] mine acquaintance into darkness. #

19_PSA_089_001 Maschil of Ethan the Ezrahite. I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever, with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations. #

19_PSA_089_002 For I have said, Mercy shall be built up for ever, thy faithfulness shalt thou establish in the very heavens. #

19_PSA_089_003 I have made a covenant with my chosen, I have sworn unto David my servant, #

19_PSA_089_004 Thy seed will I establish for ever, and build up thy throne to all generations. Selah. #

19_PSA_089_005 And the heavens shall praise thy wonders, O LORD, thy faithfulness also in the congregation of the saints. #

19_PSA_089_006 For who in the heaven can be compared unto the LORD? [who] among the sons of the mighty can be likened unto the LORD? #

19_PSA_089_007 God is greatly to be feared in the assembly of the saints, and to be had in reverence of all [them that are] about him. #

19_PSA_089_008 O LORD God of hosts, who [is] a strong LORD like unto thee? or to thy faithfulness round about thee? #

19_PSA_089_009 Thou rulest the raging of the sea, when the waves thereof arise, thou stillest them. #

19_PSA_089_010 Thou hast broken Rahab in pieces, as one that is slain; thou hast scattered thine enemies with thy strong arm. #

19_PSA_089_011 The heavens [are] thine, the earth also [is] thine, [as for] the world and the fulness thereof, thou hast founded them. #

19_PSA_089_012 The north and the south thou hast created them, Tabor and Hermon shall rejoice in thy name. #

19_PSA_089_013 Thou hast a mighty arm, strong is thy hand, [and] high is thy right hand. #

19_PSA_089_014 Justice and judgment [are] the habitation of thy throne, mercy and truth shall go before thy face. #

19_PSA_089_015 Blessed [is] the people that know the joyful sound, they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance. #

19_PSA_089_016 In thy name shall they rejoice all the day, and in thy righteousness shall they be exalted. #

19_PSA_089_017 For thou [art] the glory of their strength, and in thy favour our horn shall be exalted. #

19_PSA_089_018 For the LORD [is] our defence; and the Holy One of Israel [is] our king. #

19_PSA_089_019 Then thou spakest in vision to thy holy one, and saidst, I have laid help upon [one that is] mighty; I have exalted [one] chosen out of the people. #

19_PSA_089_020 I have found David my servant; with my holy oil have I anointed him, #

19_PSA_089_021 With whom my hand shall be established, mine arm also shall strengthen him. #

19_PSA_089_022 The enemy shall not exact upon him; nor the son of wickedness afflict him. #

19_PSA_089_023 And I will beat down his foes before his face, and plague them that hate him. #

19_PSA_089_024 But my faithfulness and my mercy [shall be] with him, and in my name shall his horn be exalted. #

19_PSA_089_025 I will set his hand also in the sea, and his right hand in the rivers. #

19_PSA_089_026 He shall cry unto me, Thou [art] my father, my God, and the rock of my salvation. #

19_PSA_089_027 Also I will make him [my] firstborn, higher than the kings of the earth. #

19_PSA_089_028 My mercy will I keep for him for evermore, and my covenant shall stand fast with him. #

19_PSA_089_029 His seed also will I make [to endure] for ever, and his throne as the days of heaven. #

19_PSA_089_030 If his children forsake my law, and walk not in my judgments; #

19_PSA_089_031 If they break my statutes, and keep not my commandments; #

19_PSA_089_032 Then will I visit their transgression with the rod, and their iniquity with stripes. #

19_PSA_089_033 Nevertheless my lovingkindness will I not utterly take from him, nor suffer my faithfulness to fail. #

19_PSA_089_034 My covenant will I not break, nor alter the thing that is gone out of my lips. #

19_PSA_089_035 Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David. #

19_PSA_089_036 His seed shall endure for ever, and his throne as the sun before me. #

19_PSA_089_037 It shall be established for ever as the moon, and [as] a faithful witness in heaven. Selah. #

19_PSA_089_038 But thou hast cast off and abhorred, thou hast been wroth with thine anointed. #

19_PSA_089_039 Thou hast made void the covenant of thy servant, thou hast profaned his crown [by casting it] to the ground. #

19_PSA_089_040 Thou hast broken down all his hedges; thou hast brought his strong holds to ruin. #

19_PSA_089_041 All that pass by the way spoil him, he is a reproach to his neighbours. #

19_PSA_089_042 Thou hast set up the right hand of his adversaries; thou hast made all his enemies to rejoice. #

19_PSA_089_043 Thou hast also turned the edge of his sword, and hast not made him to stand in the battle. #

19_PSA_089_044 Thou hast made his glory to cease, and cast his throne down to the ground. #

19_PSA_089_045 The days of his youth hast thou shortened, thou hast covered him with shame. Selah. #

19_PSA_089_046 How long, LORD? wilt thou hide thyself for ever? shall thy wrath burn like fire? #

19_PSA_089_047 Remember how short my time is, wherefore hast thou made all men in vain? #

19_PSA_089_048 What man [is he that] liveth, and shall not see death? shall he deliver his soul from the hand of the grave? Selah. #

19_PSA_089_049 Lord, where [are] thy former lovingkindnesses, [which] thou swarest unto David in thy truth? #

19_PSA_089_050 Remember, Lord, the reproach of thy servants; [how] I do bear in my bosom [the reproach of] all the mighty people; #

19_PSA_089_051 Wherewith thine enemies have reproached, O LORD; wherewith they have reproached the footsteps of thine anointed. #

19_PSA_089_052 Blessed [be] the LORD for evermore. Amen, and Amen. #

19_PSA_090_001 A Prayer of Moses the man of God. LORD, thou hast been our dwelling place in all generations. #

19_PSA_090_002 Before the mountains were brought forth, or ever thou hadst formed the earth and the world, even from everlasting to everlasting, thou [art] God. #

19_PSA_090_003 Thou turnest man to destruction; and sayest, Return, ye children of men. #

19_PSA_090_004 For a thousand years in thy sight [are but] as yesterday when it is past, and [as] a watch in the night. #

19_PSA_090_005 Thou carriest them away as with a flood; they are [as] a sleep, in the morning [they are] like grass [which] groweth up. #

19_PSA_090_006 In the morning it flourisheth, and groweth up; in the evening it is cut down, and withereth. #

19_PSA_090_007 For we are consumed by thine anger, and by thy wrath are we troubled. #

19_PSA_090_008 Thou hast set our iniquities before thee, our secret [sins] in the light of thy countenance. #

19_PSA_090_009 For all our days are passed away in thy wrath, we spend our years as a tale [that is told]. #

19_PSA_090_010 The days of our years [are] threescore years and ten; and if by reason of strength [they be] fourscore years, yet [is] their strength labour and sorrow; for it is soon cut off, and we fly away. #

19_PSA_090_011 Who knoweth the power of thine anger? even according to thy fear, [so is] thy wrath. #

19_PSA_090_012 So teach [us] to number our days, that we may apply [our] hearts unto wisdom. #

19_PSA_090_013 Return, O LORD, how long? and let it repent thee concerning thy servants. #

19_PSA_090_014 O satisfy us early with thy mercy; that we may rejoice and be glad all our days. #

19_PSA_090_015 Make us glad according to the days [wherein] thou hast afflicted us, [and] the years [wherein] we have seen evil. #

19_PSA_090_016 Let thy work appear unto thy servants, and thy glory unto their children. #

19_PSA_090_017 And let the beauty of the LORD our God be upon us, and establish thou the work of our hands upon us; yea, the work of our hands establish thou it. #

19_PSA_091_001 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. #

19_PSA_091_002 I will say of the LORD, [He is] my refuge and my fortress, my God; in him will I trust. #

19_PSA_091_003 Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, [and] from the noisome pestilence. #

19_PSA_091_004 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust, his truth [shall be thy] shield and buckler. #

19_PSA_091_005 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; [nor] for the arrow [that] flieth by day; #

19_PSA_091_006 [Nor] for the pestilence [that] walketh in darkness; [nor] for the destruction [that] wasteth at noonday. #

19_PSA_091_007 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; [but] it shall not come nigh thee. #

19_PSA_091_008 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. #

19_PSA_091_009 Because thou hast made the LORD, [which is] my refuge, [even] the most High, thy habitation; #

19_PSA_091_010 There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. #

19_PSA_091_011 For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. #

19_PSA_091_012 They shall bear thee up in [their] hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. #

19_PSA_091_013 Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder, the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet. #

19_PSA_091_014 Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him, I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. #

19_PSA_091_015 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him, I [will be] with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. #

19_PSA_091_016 With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation. #

19_PSA_092_001 A Psalm [or] Song for the sabbath day. [It is a] good [thing] to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High, #

19_PSA_092_002 To show forth thy lovingkindness in the morning, and thy faithfulness every night, #

19_PSA_092_003 Upon an instrument of ten strings, and upon the psaltery; upon the harp with a solemn sound. #

19_PSA_092_004 For thou, LORD, hast made me glad through thy work, I will triumph in the works of thy hands. #

19_PSA_092_005 O LORD, how great are thy works! [and] thy thoughts are very deep. #

19_PSA_092_006 A brutish man knoweth not; neither doth a fool understand this. #

19_PSA_092_007 When the wicked spring as the grass, and when all the workers of iniquity do flourish; [it is] that they shall be destroyed for ever, #

19_PSA_092_008 But thou, LORD, [art most] high for evermore. #

19_PSA_092_009 For, lo, thine enemies, O LORD, for, lo, thine enemies shall perish; all the workers of iniquity shall be scattered. #

19_PSA_092_010 But my horn shalt thou exalt like [the horn of] an unicorn, I shall be anointed with fresh oil. #

19_PSA_092_011 Mine eye also shall see [my desire] on mine enemies, [and] mine ears shall hear [my desire] of the wicked that rise up against me. #

19_PSA_092_012 The righteous shall flourish like the palm tree, he shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. #

19_PSA_092_013 Those that be planted in the house of the LORD shall flourish in the courts of our God. #

19_PSA_092_014 They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing; #

19_PSA_092_015 To show that the LORD [is] upright, [he is] my rock, and [there is] no unrighteousness in him. #

19_PSA_093_001 The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, [wherewith] he hath girded himself, the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved. #

19_PSA_093_002 Thy throne [is] established of old, thou [art] from everlasting. #

19_PSA_093_003 The floods have lifted up, O LORD, the floods have lifted up their voice; the floods lift up their waves. #

19_PSA_093_004 The LORD on high [is] mightier than the noise of many waters, [yea, than] the mighty waves of the sea. #

19_PSA_093_005 Thy testimonies are very sure, holiness becometh thine house, O LORD, for ever. #

19_PSA_094_001 O LORD God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, show thyself. #

19_PSA_094_002 Lift up thyself, thou judge of the earth, render a reward to the proud. #

19_PSA_094_003 LORD, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked triumph? #

19_PSA_094_004 [How long] shall they utter [and] speak hard things? [and] all the workers of iniquity boast themselves? #

19_PSA_094_005 They break in pieces thy people, O LORD, and afflict thine heritage. #

19_PSA_094_006 They slay the widow and the stranger, and murder the fatherless. #

19_PSA_094_007 Yet they say, The LORD shall not see, neither shall the God of Jacob regard [it]. #

19_PSA_094_008 Understand, ye brutish among the people, and [ye] fools, when will ye be wise? #

19_PSA_094_009 He that planted the ear, shall he not hear? he that formed the eye, shall he not see? #

19_PSA_094_010 He that chastiseth the heathen, shall not he correct? he that teacheth man knowledge, [shall not he know]? #

19_PSA_094_011 The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they [are] vanity. #

19_PSA_094_012 Blessed [is] the man whom thou chastenest, O LORD, and teachest him out of thy law; #

19_PSA_094_013 That thou mayest give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked. #

19_PSA_094_014 For the LORD will not cast off his people, neither will he forsake his inheritance. #

19_PSA_094_015 But judgment shall return unto righteousness, and all the upright in heart shall follow it. #

19_PSA_094_016 Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? [or] who will stand up for me against the workers of iniquity? #

19_PSA_094_017 Unless the LORD [had been] my help, my soul had almost dwelt in silence. #

19_PSA_094_018 When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up. #

19_PSA_094_019 In the multitude of my thoughts within me thy comforts delight my soul. #

19_PSA_094_020 Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law? #

19_PSA_094_021 They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and condemn the innocent blood. #

19_PSA_094_022 But the LORD is my defence; and my God [is] the rock of my refuge. #

19_PSA_094_023 And he shall bring upon them their own iniquity, and shall cut them off in their own wickedness; [yea], the LORD our God shall cut them off. #

19_PSA_095_001 O come, let us sing unto the LORD, let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. #

19_PSA_095_002 Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms. #

19_PSA_095_003 For the LORD [is] a great God, and a great King above all gods. #

19_PSA_095_004 In his hand [are] the deep places of the earth, the strength of the hills [is] his also. #

19_PSA_095_005 The sea [is] his, and he made it, and his hands formed the dry [land]. #

19_PSA_095_006 O come, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before the LORD our maker. #

19_PSA_095_007 For he [is] our God; and we [are] the people of his pasture, and the sheep of his hand. To day if ye will hear his voice, #

19_PSA_095_008 Harden not your heart, as in the provocation, [and] as [in] the day of temptation in the wilderness, #

19_PSA_095_009 When your fathers tempted me, proved me, and saw my work. #

19_PSA_095_010 Forty years long was I grieved with [this] generation, and said, It [is] a people that do err in their heart, and they have not known my ways, #

19_PSA_095_011 Unto whom I swear in my wrath that they should not enter into my rest. #

19_PSA_096_001 O sing unto the LORD a new song, sing unto the LORD, all the earth. #

19_PSA_096_002 Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; show forth his salvation from day to day. #

19_PSA_096_003 Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people. #

19_PSA_096_004 For the LORD [is] great, and greatly to be praised, he [is] to be feared above all gods. #

19_PSA_096_005 For all the gods of the nations [are] idols, but the LORD made the heavens. #

19_PSA_096_006 Honour and majesty [are] before him, strength and beauty [are] in his sanctuary. #

19_PSA_096_007 Give unto the LORD, O ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength. #

19_PSA_096_008 Give unto the LORD the glory [due unto] his name, bring an offering, and come into his courts. #

19_PSA_096_009 O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness, fear before him, all the earth. #

19_PSA_096_010 Say among the heathen [that] the LORD reigneth, the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved, he shall judge the people righteously. #

19_PSA_096_011 Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof. #

19_PSA_096_012 Let the field be joyful, and all that [is] therein, then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice #

19_PSA_096_013 Before the LORD, for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth, he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth. #

19_PSA_097_001 The LORD reigneth; let the earth rejoice; let the multitude of isles be glad [thereof]. #

19_PSA_097_002 Clouds and darkness [are] round about him, righteousness and judgment [are] the habitation of his throne. #

19_PSA_097_003 A fire goeth before him, and burneth up his enemies round about. #

19_PSA_097_004 His lightnings enlightened the world, the earth saw, and trembled. #

19_PSA_097_005 The hills melted like wax at the presence of the LORD, at the presence of the Lord of the whole earth. #

19_PSA_097_006 The heavens declare his righteousness, and all the people see his glory. #

19_PSA_097_007 Confounded be all they that serve graven images, that boast themselves of idols, worship him, all [ye] gods. #

19_PSA_097_008 Zion heard, and was glad; and the daughters of Judah rejoiced because of thy judgments, O LORD. #

19_PSA_097_009 For thou, LORD, [art] high above all the earth, thou art exalted far above all gods. #

19_PSA_097_010 Ye that love the LORD, hate evil, he preserveth the souls of his saints; he delivereth them out of the hand of the wicked. #

19_PSA_097_011 Light is sown for the righteous, and gladness for the upright in heart. #

19_PSA_097_012 Rejoice in the LORD, ye righteous; and give thanks at the remembrance of his holiness. #

19_PSA_098_001 A Psalm. O sing unto the LORD a new song; for he hath done marvellous things, his right hand, and his holy arm, hath gotten him the victory. #

19_PSA_098_002 The LORD hath made known his salvation, his righteousness hath he openly showed in the sight of the heathen. #

19_PSA_098_003 He hath remembered his mercy and his truth toward the house of Israel, all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God. #

19_PSA_098_004 Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all the earth, make a loud noise, and rejoice, and sing praise. #

19_PSA_098_005 Sing unto the LORD with the harp; with the harp, and the voice of a psalm. #

19_PSA_098_006 With trumpets and sound of cornet make a joyful noise before the LORD, the King. #

19_PSA_098_007 Let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof; the world, and they that dwell therein. #

19_PSA_098_008 Let the floods clap [their] hands, let the hills be joyful together #

19_PSA_098_009 Before the LORD; for he cometh to judge the earth, with righteousness shall he judge the world, and the people with equity. #

19_PSA_099_001 The LORD reigneth; let the people tremble, he sitteth [between] the cherubims; let the earth be moved. #

19_PSA_099_002 The LORD [is] great in Zion; and he [is] high above all the people. #

19_PSA_099_003 Let them praise thy great and terrible name; [for] it [is] holy. #

19_PSA_099_004 The king's strength also loveth judgment; thou dost establish equity, thou executest judgment and righteousness in Jacob. #

19_PSA_099_005 Exalt ye the LORD our God, and worship at his footstool; [for] he [is] holy. #

19_PSA_099_006 Moses and Aaron among his priests, and Samuel among them that call upon his name; they called upon the LORD, and he answered them. #

19_PSA_099_007 He spake unto them in the cloudy pillar, they kept his testimonies, and the ordinance [that] he gave them. #

19_PSA_099_008 Thou answeredst them, O LORD our God, thou wast a God that forgavest them, though thou tookest vengeance of their inventions. #

19_PSA_099_009 Exalt the LORD our God, and worship at his holy hill; for the LORD our God [is] holy. #

19_PSA_100_001 A Psalm of praise. **Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.**
#

19_PSA_100_002 **Serve the LORD with gladness, come before his presence with singing.** #

19_PSA_100_003 **Know ye that the LORD he [is] God, [it is] he [that] hath made us, and not we ourselves; [we are] his people, and the sheep of his pasture.** #

19_PSA_100_004 **Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, [and] into his courts with praise, be thankful unto him, [and] bless his name.** #

19_PSA_100_005 **For the LORD [is] good; his mercy [is] everlasting; and his truth [endureth] to all generations.** #

19_PSA_101_001 A Psalm of David. **I will sing of mercy and judgment, unto thee, O LORD, will I sing.** #

19_PSA_101_002 **I will behave myself wisely in a perfect way. O when wilt thou come unto me? I will walk within my house with a perfect heart.** #

19_PSA_101_003 **I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes, I hate the work of them that turn aside; [it] shall not cleave to me.** #

19_PSA_101_004 A froward heart shall depart from me, **I will not know a wicked [person].** #

19_PSA_101_005 **Whoso privily slandereth his neighbour, him will I cut off, him that hath an high look and a proud heart will not I suffer.** #

19_PSA_101_006 **Mine eyes [shall be] upon the faithful of the land, that they may dwell with me, he that walketh in a perfect way, he shall serve me.** #

19_PSA_101_007 **He that worketh deceit shall not dwell within my house, he that telleth lies shall not tarry in my sight.** #

19_PSA_101_008 **I will early destroy all the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the LORD.** #

19_PSA_102_001 A Prayer of the afflicted, when he is overwhelmed, and poureth out his complaint before the LORD. **Hear my prayer, O LORD, and let my cry come unto thee.** #

19_PSA_102_002 **Hide not thy face from me in the day [when] I am in trouble; incline thine ear unto me, in the day [when] I call answer me speedily.** #

19_PSA_102_003 **For my days are consumed like smoke, and my bones are burned as an hearth.** #

19_PSA_102_004 **My heart is smitten, and withered like grass; so that I forget to eat my bread.** #

19_PSA_102_005 **By reason of the voice of my groaning my bones cleave to my skin.** #

19_PSA_102_006 I am like a pelican of the wilderness, I am like an owl of the desert. #

19_PSA_102_007 I watch, and am as a sparrow alone upon the house top. #

19_PSA_102_008 Mine enemies reproach me all the day; [and] they that are mad against me are sworn against me. #

19_PSA_102_009 For I have eaten ashes like bread, and mingled my drink with weeping, #

19_PSA_102_010 Because of thine indignation and thy wrath, for thou hast lifted me up, and cast me down. #

19_PSA_102_011 My days [are] like a shadow that declineth; and I am withered like grass. #

19_PSA_102_012 But thou, O LORD, shalt endure for ever; and thy remembrance unto all generations. #

19_PSA_102_013 Thou shalt arise, [and] have mercy upon Zion, for the time to favour her, yea, the set time, is come. #

19_PSA_102_014 For thy servants take pleasure in her stones, and favour the dust thereof. #

19_PSA_102_015 So the heathen shall fear the name of the LORD, and all the kings of the earth thy glory. #

19_PSA_102_016 When the LORD shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory. #

19_PSA_102_017 He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer. #

19_PSA_102_018 This shall be written for the generation to come, and the people which shall be created shall praise the LORD. #

19_PSA_102_019 For he hath looked down from the height of his sanctuary; from heaven did the LORD behold the earth; #

19_PSA_102_020 To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death; #

19_PSA_102_021 To declare the name of the LORD in Zion, and his praise in Jerusalem; #

19_PSA_102_022 When the people are gathered together, and the kingdoms, to serve the LORD. #

19_PSA_102_023 He weakened my strength in the way; he shortened my days. #

19_PSA_102_024 I said, O my God, take me not away in the midst of my days, thy years [are] throughout all generations. #

19_PSA_102_025 Of old hast thou laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens [are] the work of thy hands. #

19_PSA_102_026 They shall perish, but thou shalt endure, yea, all of them shall wax old like a garment; as a vesture shalt thou change them, and they shall be changed, #

19_PSA_102_027 But thou [art] the same, and thy years shall have no end. #

19_PSA_102_028 The children of thy servants shall continue, and their seed shall be established before thee. #

19_PSA_103_001 [A Psalm] of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and all that is within me, [bless] his holy name. #

19_PSA_103_002 Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits, #

19_PSA_103_003 Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; #

19_PSA_103_004 Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; #

19_PSA_103_005 Who satisfieth thy mouth with good [things; so that] thy youth is renewed like the eagle's. #

19_PSA_103_006 The LORD executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed. #

19_PSA_103_007 He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel. #

19_PSA_103_008 The LORD [is] merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. #

19_PSA_103_009 He will not always chide, neither will he keep [his anger] for ever. #

19_PSA_103_010 He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. #

19_PSA_103_011 For as the heaven is high above the earth, [so] great is his mercy toward them that fear him. #

19_PSA_103_012 As far as the east is from the west, [so] far hath he removed our transgressions from us. #

19_PSA_103_013 Like as a father pitieth [his] children, [so] the LORD pitieth them that fear him. #

19_PSA_103_014 For he knoweth our frame; he remembereth that we [are] dust. #

19_PSA_103_015 [As for] man, his days [are] as grass, as a flower of the field, so he flourisheth. #

19_PSA_103_016 For the wind passeth over it, and it is gone; and the place thereof shall know it no more. #

19_PSA_103_017 But the mercy of the LORD [is] from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children; #

19_PSA_103_018 To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them. #

19_PSA_103_019 The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth over all. #

19_PSA_103_020 Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word. #

19_PSA_103_021 Bless ye the LORD, all [ye] his hosts; [ye] ministers of his, that do his pleasure. #

19_PSA_103_022 Bless the LORD, all his works in all places of his dominion, bless the LORD, O my soul. #

19_PSA_104_001 Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty. #

19_PSA_104_002 Who coverest [thyself] with light as [with] a garment, who stretchest out the heavens like a curtain, #

19_PSA_104_003 Who layeth the beams of his chambers in the waters, who maketh the clouds his chariot, who walketh upon the wings of the wind, #

19_PSA_104_004 Who maketh his angels spirits; his ministers a flaming fire, #

19_PSA_104_005 [Who] laid the foundations of the earth, [that] it should not be removed for ever. #

19_PSA_104_006 Thou coveredst it with the deep as [with] a garment, the waters stood above the mountains. #

19_PSA_104_007 At thy rebuke they fled; at the voice of thy thunder they hasted away. #

19_PSA_104_008 They go up by the mountains; they go down by the valleys unto the place which thou hast founded for them. #

19_PSA_104_009 Thou hast set a bound that they may not pass over; that they turn not again to cover the earth. #

19_PSA_104_010 He sendeth the springs into the valleys, [which] run among the hills. #

19_PSA_104_011 They give drink to every beast of the field, the wild asses quench their thirst. #

19_PSA_104_012 By them shall the fowls of the heaven have their habitation, [which] sing among the branches. #

19_PSA_104_013 He watereth the hills from his chambers, the earth is satisfied with the fruit of thy works. #

19_PSA_104_014 He causeth the grass to grow for the cattle, and herb for the service of man, that he may bring forth food out of the earth; #

19_PSA_104_015 And wine [that] maketh glad the heart of man, [and] oil to make [his] face to shine, and bread [which] strengtheneth man's heart. #

19_PSA_104_016 The trees of the LORD are full [of sap]; the cedars of Lebanon, which he hath planted; #

19_PSA_104_017 Where the birds make their nests, [as for] the stork, the fir trees [are] her house. #

19_PSA_104_018 The high hills [are] a refuge for the wild goats; [and] the rocks for the conies. #

19_PSA_104_019 He appointed the moon for seasons, the sun knoweth his going down. #

19_PSA_104_020 Thou makest darkness, and it is night, wherein all the beasts of the forest do creep [forth]. #

19_PSA_104_021 The young lions roar after their prey, and seek their meat from God. #

19_PSA_104_022 The sun ariseth, they gather themselves together, and lay them down in their dens. #

19_PSA_104_023 Man goeth forth unto his work and to his labour until the evening. #

19_PSA_104_024 O LORD, how manifold are thy works! in wisdom hast thou made them all, the earth is full of thy riches. #

19_PSA_104_025 [So is] this great and wide sea, wherein [are] things creeping innumerable, both small and great beasts. #

19_PSA_104_026 There go the ships, [there is] that leviathan, [whom] thou hast made to play therein. #

19_PSA_104_027 These wait all upon thee; that thou mayest give [them] their meat in due season. #

19_PSA_104_028 [That] thou givest them they gather, thou openest thine hand, they are filled with good. #

19_PSA_104_029 Thou hidest thy face, they are troubled, thou takest away their breath, they die, and return to their dust. #

19_PSA_104_030 Thou sendest forth thy spirit, they are created, and thou renewest the face of the earth. #

19_PSA_104_031 The glory of the LORD shall endure for ever, the LORD shall rejoice in his works. #

19_PSA_104_032 He looketh on the earth, and it trembleth, he toucheth the hills, and they smoke. #

19_PSA_104_033 I will sing unto the LORD as long as I live, I will sing praise to my God while I have my being. #

19_PSA_104_034 My meditation of him shall be sweet, I will be glad in the LORD. #

19_PSA_104_035 Let the sinners be consumed out of the earth, and let the wicked be no more. Bless thou the LORD, O my soul. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_105_001 O give thanks unto the LORD; call upon his name, make known his deeds among the people. #

19_PSA_105_002 Sing unto him, sing psalms unto him, talk ye of all his wondrous works. #

19_PSA_105_003 Glory ye in his holy name, let the heart of them rejoice that seek the LORD. #

19_PSA_105_004 Seek the LORD, and his strength, seek his face evermore. #

19_PSA_105_005 Remember his marvellous works that he hath done; his wonders, and the judgments of his mouth; #

19_PSA_105_006 O ye seed of Abraham his servant, ye children of Jacob his chosen. #

19_PSA_105_007 He [is] the LORD our God, his judgments [are] in all the earth. #

19_PSA_105_008 He hath remembered his covenant for ever, the word [which] he commanded to a thousand generations. #

19_PSA_105_009 Which [covenant] he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac; #

19_PSA_105_010 And confirmed the same unto Jacob for a law, [and] to Israel [for] an everlasting covenant, #

19_PSA_105_011 Saying, Unto thee will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance, #

19_PSA_105_012 When they were [but] a few men in number; yea, very few, and strangers in it. #

19_PSA_105_013 When they went from one nation to another, from [one] kingdom to another people; #

19_PSA_105_014 He suffered no man to do them wrong, yea, he reproveth kings for their sakes; #

19_PSA_105_015 [Saying], Touch not mine anointed, and do my prophets no harm. #

19_PSA_105_016 Moreover he called for a famine upon the land, he brake the whole staff of bread. #

19_PSA_105_017 He sent a man before them, [even] Joseph, [who] was sold for a servant, #

19_PSA_105_018 Whose feet they hurt with fetters, he was laid in iron, #

19_PSA_105_019 Until the time that his word came, the word of the LORD tried him. #

19_PSA_105_020 The king sent and loosed him; [even] the ruler of the people, and let him go free. #

19_PSA_105_021 He made him lord of his house, and ruler of all his substance, #

19_PSA_105_022 To bind his princes at his pleasure; and teach his senators wisdom. #

19_PSA_105_023 Israel also came into Egypt; and Jacob sojourned in the land of Ham. #

19_PSA_105_024 And he increased his people greatly; and made them stronger than their enemies. #

19_PSA_105_025 He turned their heart to hate his people, to deal subtly with his servants. #

19_PSA_105_026 He sent Moses his servant; [and] Aaron whom he had chosen. #

19_PSA_105_027 They showed his signs among them, and wonders in the land of Ham. #

19_PSA_105_028 He sent darkness, and made it dark; and they rebelled not against his word. #

19_PSA_105_029 He turned their waters into blood, and slew their fish. #

19_PSA_105_030 Their land brought forth frogs in abundance, in the chambers of their kings. #

19_PSA_105_031 He spake, and there came divers sorts of flies, [and] lice in all their coasts. #

19_PSA_105_032 He gave them hail for rain, [and] flaming fire in their land. #

19_PSA_105_033 He smote their vines also and their fig trees; and brake the trees of their coasts. #

19_PSA_105_034 He spake, and the locusts came, and caterpillars, and that without number, #

19_PSA_105_035 And did eat up all the herbs in their land, and devoured the fruit of their ground. #

19_PSA_105_036 He smote also all the firstborn in their land, the chief of all their strength. #

19_PSA_105_037 He brought them forth also with silver and gold, and [there was] not one feeble [person] among their tribes. #

19_PSA_105_038 Egypt was glad when they departed, for the fear of them fell upon them. #

19_PSA_105_039 He spread a cloud for a covering; and fire to give light in the night. #

19_PSA_105_040 [The people] asked, and he brought quails, and satisfied them with the bread of heaven. #

19_PSA_105_041 He opened the rock, and the waters gushed out; they ran in the dry places [like] a river. #

19_PSA_105_042 For he remembered his holy promise, [and] Abraham his servant. #

19_PSA_105_043 And he brought forth his people with joy, [and] his chosen with gladness, #

19_PSA_105_044 And gave them the lands of the heathen, and they inherited the labour of the people; #

19_PSA_105_045 That they might observe his statutes, and keep his laws. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_106_001 Praise ye the LORD. O give thanks unto the LORD; for [he is] good, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_106_002 Who can utter the mighty acts of the LORD? [who] can show forth all his praise? #

19_PSA_106_003 Blessed [are] they that keep judgment, [and] he that doeth righteousness at all times. #

19_PSA_106_004 Remember me, O LORD, with the favour [that thou bearest unto] thy people, O visit me with thy salvation; #

19_PSA_106_005 That I may see the good of thy chosen, that I may rejoice in the gladness of thy nation, that I may glory with thine inheritance. #

19_PSA_106_006 We have sinned with our fathers, we have committed iniquity, we have done wickedly. #

19_PSA_106_007 Our fathers understood not thy wonders in Egypt; they remembered not the multitude of thy mercies; but provoked [him] at the sea, [even] at the Red sea. #

19_PSA_106_008 Nevertheless he saved them for his name's sake, that he might make his mighty power to be known. #

19_PSA_106_009 He rebuked the Red sea also, and it was dried up, so he led them through the depths, as through the wilderness. #

19_PSA_106_010 And he saved them from the hand of him that hated [them], and redeemed them from the hand of the enemy. #

19_PSA_106_011 And the waters covered their enemies, there was not one of them left. #

19_PSA_106_012 Then believed they his words; they sang his praise. #

19_PSA_106_013 They soon forgat his works; they waited not for his counsel, #

19_PSA_106_014 But lusted exceedingly in the wilderness, and tempted God in the desert. #

19_PSA_106_015 And he gave them their request; but sent leanness into their soul. #

19_PSA_106_016 They envied Moses also in the camp, [and] Aaron the saint of the LORD. #

19_PSA_106_017 The earth opened and swallowed up Dathan, and covered the company of Abiram. #

19_PSA_106_018 And a fire was kindled in their company; the flame burned up the wicked. #

19_PSA_106_019 They made a calf in Horeb, and worshipped the molten image. #

19_PSA_106_020 Thus they changed their glory into the similitude of an ox that eateeth grass. #

19_PSA_106_021 They forgat God their saviour, which had done great things in Egypt; #

19_PSA_106_022 Wondrous works in the land of Ham, [and] terrible things by the Red sea. #

19_PSA_106_023 Therefore he said that he would destroy them, had not Moses his chosen stood before him in the breach, to turn away his wrath, lest he should destroy [them]. #

19_PSA_106_024 Yea, they despised the pleasant land, they believed not his word, #

19_PSA_106_025 But murmured in their tents, [and] hearkened not unto the voice of the LORD. #

19_PSA_106_026 Therefore he lifted up his hand against them, to overthrow them in the wilderness, #

19_PSA_106_027 To overthrow their seed also among the nations, and to scatter them in the lands. #

19_PSA_106_028 They joined themselves also unto Baalpeor, and ate the sacrifices of the dead. #

19_PSA_106_029 Thus they provoked [him] to anger with their inventions, and the plague brake in upon them. #

19_PSA_106_030 Then stood up Phinehas, and executed judgment, and [so] the plague was stayed. #

19_PSA_106_031 And that was counted unto him for righteousness unto all generations for evermore. #

19_PSA_106_032 They angered [him] also at the waters of strife, so that it went ill with Moses for their sakes, #

19_PSA_106_033 Because they provoked his spirit, so that he spake unadvisedly with his lips. #

19_PSA_106_034 They did not destroy the nations, concerning whom the LORD commanded them, #

19_PSA_106_035 But were mingled among the heathen, and learned their works. #

19_PSA_106_036 And they served their idols, which were a snare unto them. #

19_PSA_106_037 Yea, they sacrificed their sons and their daughters unto devils, #

19_PSA_106_038 And shed innocent blood, [even] the blood of their sons and of their daughters, whom they sacrificed unto the idols of Canaan, and the land was polluted with blood. #

19_PSA_106_039 Thus were they defiled with their own works, and went a whoring with their own inventions. #

19_PSA_106_040 Therefore was the wrath of the LORD kindled against his people, insomuch that he abhorred his own inheritance. #

19_PSA_106_041 And he gave them into the hand of the heathen; and they that hated them ruled over them. #

19_PSA_106_042 Their enemies also oppressed them, and they were brought into subjection under their hand. #

19_PSA_106_043 Many times did he deliver them; but they provoked [him] with their counsel, and were brought low for their iniquity. #

19_PSA_106_044 Nevertheless he regarded their affliction, when he heard their cry, #

19_PSA_106_045 And he remembered for them his covenant, and repented according to the multitude of his mercies. #

19_PSA_106_046 He made them also to be pitied of all those that carried them captives. #

19_PSA_106_047 Save us, O LORD our God, and gather us from among the heathen, to give thanks unto thy holy name, [and] to triumph in thy praise. #

19_PSA_106_048 Blessed [be] the LORD God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting, and let all the people say, Amen. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_107_001 O give thanks unto the LORD, for [he is] good, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_107_002 Let the redeemed of the LORD say [so], whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy; #

19_PSA_107_003 And gathered them out of the lands, from the east, and from the west, from the north, and from the south. #

19_PSA_107_004 They wandered in the wilderness in a solitary way; they found no city to dwell in. #

19_PSA_107_005 Hungry and thirsty, their soul fainted in them. #

19_PSA_107_006 Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, [and] he delivered them out of their distresses. #

19_PSA_107_007 And he led them forth by the right way, that they might go to a city of habitation. #

19_PSA_107_008 Oh that [men] would praise the LORD [for] his goodness, and [for] his wonderful works to the children of men! #

19_PSA_107_009 For he satisfieth the longing soul, and filleth the hungry soul with goodness. #

19_PSA_107_010 Such as sit in darkness and in the shadow of death, [being] bound in affliction and iron; #

19_PSA_107_011 Because they rebelled against the words of God, and contemned the counsel of the most High, #

19_PSA_107_012 Therefore he brought down their heart with labour; they fell down, and [there was] none to help. #

19_PSA_107_013 Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, [and] he saved them out of their distresses. #

19_PSA_107_014 He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death, and brake their bands in sunder. #

19_PSA_107_015 Oh that [men] would praise the LORD [for] his goodness, and [for] his wonderful works to the children of men! #

19_PSA_107_016 For he hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder. #

19_PSA_107_017 Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. #

19_PSA_107_018 Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death. #

19_PSA_107_019 Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, [and] he saveth them out of their distresses. #

19_PSA_107_020 He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered [them] from their destructions. #

19_PSA_107_021 Oh that [men] would praise the LORD [for] his goodness, and [for] his wonderful works to the children of men! #

19_PSA_107_022 And let them sacrifice the sacrifices of thanksgiving, and declare his works with rejoicing. #

19_PSA_107_023 They that go down to the sea in ships, that do business in great waters; #

19_PSA_107_024 These see the works of the LORD, and his wonders in the deep. #

19_PSA_107_025 For he commandeth, and raiseth the stormy wind, which lifteth up the waves thereof. #

19_PSA_107_026 They mount up to the heaven, they go down again to the depths, their soul is melted because of trouble. #

19_PSA_107_027 They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wit's end. #

19_PSA_107_028 Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses. #

19_PSA_107_029 He maketh the storm a calm, so that the waves thereof are still. #

19_PSA_107_030 Then are they glad because they be quiet; so he bringeth them unto their desired haven. #

19_PSA_107_031 Oh that [men] would praise the LORD [for] his goodness, and [for] his wonderful works to the children of men! #

19_PSA_107_032 Let them exalt him also in the congregation of the people, and praise him in the assembly of the elders. #

19_PSA_107_033 He turneth rivers into a wilderness, and the watersprings into dry ground; #

19_PSA_107_034 A fruitful land into barrenness, for the wickedness of them that dwell therein. #

19_PSA_107_035 He turneth the wilderness into a standing water, and dry ground into watersprings. #

19_PSA_107_036 And there he maketh the hungry to dwell, that they may prepare a city for habitation; #

19_PSA_107_037 And sow the fields, and plant vineyards, which may yield fruits of increase. #

19_PSA_107_038 He blesseth them also, so that they are multiplied greatly; and suffereth not their cattle to decrease. #

19_PSA_107_039 Again, they are minished and brought low through oppression, affliction, and sorrow. #

19_PSA_107_040 He poureth contempt upon princes, and causeth them to wander in the wilderness, [where there is] no way. #

19_PSA_107_041 Yet setteth he the poor on high from affliction, and maketh [him] families like a flock. #

19_PSA_107_042 The righteous shall see [it], and rejoice, and all iniquity shall stop her mouth. #

19_PSA_107_043 Whoso [is] wise, and will observe these [things], even they shall understand the lovingkindness of the LORD. #

19_PSA_108_001 A Song [or] Psalm of David. O God, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory. #

19_PSA_108_002 Awake, psaltery and harp, I [myself] will awake early. #

19_PSA_108_003 I will praise thee, O LORD, among the people, and I will sing praises unto thee among the nations. #

19_PSA_108_004 For thy mercy [is] great above the heavens, and thy truth [reacheth] unto the clouds. #

19_PSA_108_005 Be thou exalted, O God, above the heavens, and thy glory above all the earth; #

19_PSA_108_006 That thy beloved may be delivered, save [with] thy right hand, and answer me. #

19_PSA_108_007 God hath spoken in his holiness; I will rejoice, I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth. #

19_PSA_108_008 Gilead [is] mine; Manasseh [is] mine; Ephraim also [is] the strength of mine head; Judah [is] my lawgiver; #

19_PSA_108_009 Moab [is] my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe; over Philistia will I triumph. #

19_PSA_108_010 Who will bring me into the strong city? who will lead me into Edom? #

19_PSA_108_011 [Wilt] not [thou], O God, [who] hast cast us off? and wilt not thou, O God, go forth with our hosts? #

19_PSA_108_012 Give us help from trouble, for vain [is] the help of man. #

19_PSA_108_013 Through God we shall do valiantly, for he [it is that] shall tread down our enemies. #

19_PSA_109_001 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Hold not thy peace, O God of my praise; #

19_PSA_109_002 For the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the deceitful are opened against me, they have spoken against me with a lying tongue. #

19_PSA_109_003 They compassed me about also with words of hatred; and fought against me without a cause. #

19_PSA_109_004 For my love they are my adversaries, but I [give myself unto] prayer. #

19_PSA_109_005 And they have rewarded me evil for good, and hatred for my love. #

19_PSA_109_006 Set thou a wicked man over him, and let Satan stand at his right hand. #

19_PSA_109_007 When he shall be judged, let him be condemned, and let his prayer become sin. #

19_PSA_109_008 Let his days be few; [and] let another take his office. #

19_PSA_109_009 Let his children be fatherless, and his wife a widow. #

19_PSA_109_010 Let his children be continually vagabonds, and beg, let them seek [their bread] also out of their desolate places. #

19_PSA_109_011 Let the extortioner catch all that he hath; and let the strangers spoil his labour. #

19_PSA_109_012 Let there be none to extend mercy unto him, neither let there be any to favour his fatherless children. #

19_PSA_109_013 Let his posterity be cut off; [and] in the generation following let their name be blotted out. #

19_PSA_109_014 Let the iniquity of his fathers be remembered with the LORD; and let not the sin of his mother be blotted out. #

19_PSA_109_015 Let them be before the LORD continually, that he may cut off the memory of them from the earth. #

19_PSA_109_016 Because that he remembered not to show mercy, but persecuted the poor and needy man, that he might even slay the broken in heart. #

19_PSA_109_017 As he loved cursing, so let it come unto him, as he delighted not in blessing, so let it be far from him. #

19_PSA_109_018 As he clothed himself with cursing like as with his garment, so let it come into his bowels like water, and like oil into his bones. #

19_PSA_109_019 Let it be unto him as the garment [which] covereth him, and for a girdle wherewith he is girded continually. #

19_PSA_109_020 [Let] this [be] the reward of mine adversaries from the LORD, and of them that speak evil against my soul. #

19_PSA_109_021 But do thou for me, O GOD the Lord, for thy name's sake, because thy mercy [is] good, deliver thou me. #

19_PSA_109_022 For I [am] poor and needy, and my heart is wounded within me. #

19_PSA_109_023 I am gone like the shadow when it declineth, I am tossed up and down as the locust. #

19_PSA_109_024 My knees are weak through fasting; and my flesh faileth of fatness. #

19_PSA_109_025 I became also a reproach unto them, [when] they looked upon me they shook their heads. #

19_PSA_109_026 Help me, O LORD my God, O save me according to thy mercy, #

19_PSA_109_027 That they may know that this [is] thy hand; [that] thou, LORD, hast done it. #

19_PSA_109_028 Let them curse, but bless thou, when they arise, let them be ashamed; but let thy servant rejoice. #

19_PSA_109_029 Let mine adversaries be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their own confusion, as with a mantle. #

19_PSA_109_030 I will greatly praise the LORD with my mouth; yea, I will praise him among the multitude. #

19_PSA_109_031 For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save [him] from those that condemn his soul. #

19_PSA_110_001 A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool. #

19_PSA_110_002 The LORD shall send the rod of thy strength out of Zion, rule thou in the midst of thine enemies. #

19_PSA_110_003 Thy people [shall be] willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning, thou hast the dew of thy youth. #

19_PSA_110_004 The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou [art] a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek. #

19_PSA_110_005 The Lord at thy right hand shall strike through kings in the day of his wrath. #

19_PSA_110_006 He shall judge among the heathen, he shall fill [the places] with the dead bodies; he shall wound the heads over many countries. #

19_PSA_110_007 He shall drink of the brook in the way, therefore shall he lift up the head. #

19_PSA_111_001 Praise ye the LORD. I will praise the LORD with [my] whole heart, in the assembly of the upright, and [in] the congregation. #

19_PSA_111_002 The works of the LORD [are] great, sought out of all them that have pleasure therein. #

19_PSA_111_003 His work [is] honourable and glorious, and his righteousness endureth for ever. #

19_PSA_111_004 He hath made his wonderful works to be remembered, the LORD [is] gracious and full of compassion. #

19_PSA_111_005 He hath given meat unto them that fear him, he will ever be mindful of his covenant. #

19_PSA_111_006 He hath showed his people the power of his works, that he may give them the heritage of the heathen. #

19_PSA_111_007 The works of his hands [are] verity and judgment; all his commandments [are] sure. #

19_PSA_111_008 They stand fast for ever and ever, [and are] done in truth and uprightness. #

19_PSA_111_009 He sent redemption unto his people, he hath commanded his covenant for ever, holy and reverend [is] his name. #

19_PSA_111_010 The fear of the LORD [is] the beginning of wisdom, a good understanding have all they that do [his commandments], his praise endureth for ever. #

19_PSA_112_001 Praise ye the LORD. Blessed [is] the man [that] feareth the LORD, [that] delighteth greatly in his commandments. #

19_PSA_112_002 His seed shall be mighty upon earth, the generation of the upright shall be blessed. #

19_PSA_112_003 Wealth and riches [shall be] in his house, and his righteousness endureth for ever. #

19_PSA_112_004 Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness, [he is] gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous. #

19_PSA_112_005 A good man showeth favour, and lendeth, he will guide his affairs with discretion. #

19_PSA_112_006 Surely he shall not be moved for ever, the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance. #

19_PSA_112_007 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings, his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD. #

19_PSA_112_008 His heart [is] established, he shall not be afraid, until he see [his desire] upon his enemies. #

19_PSA_112_009 He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness endureth for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour. #

19_PSA_112_010 The wicked shall see [it], and be grieved; he shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away, the desire of the wicked shall perish. #

19_PSA_113_001 Praise ye the LORD. Praise, O ye servants of the LORD, praise the name of the LORD. #

19_PSA_113_002 Blessed be the name of the LORD from this time forth and for evermore. #

19_PSA_113_003 From the rising of the sun unto the going down of the same the LORD's name [is] to be praised. #

19_PSA_113_004 The LORD [is] high above all nations, [and] his glory above the heavens. #

19_PSA_113_005 Who [is] like unto the LORD our God, who dwelleth on high, #

19_PSA_113_006 Who humbleth [himself] to behold [the things that are] in heaven, and in the earth! #

19_PSA_113_007 He raiseth up the poor out of the dust, [and] lifteth the needy out of the dunghill; #

19_PSA_113_008 That he may set [him] with princes, [even] with the princes of his people. #

19_PSA_113_009 He maketh the barren woman to keep house, [and to be] a joyful mother of children. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_114_001 When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language; #

19_PSA_114_002 Judah was his sanctuary, [and] Israel his dominion. #

19_PSA_114_003 The sea saw [it], and fled, Jordan was driven back. #

19_PSA_114_004 The mountains skipped like rams, [and] the little hills like lambs. #

19_PSA_114_005 What [ailed] thee, O thou sea, that thou fleddest? thou Jordan, [that] thou wast driven back? #

19_PSA_114_006 Ye mountains, [that] ye skipped like rams; [and] ye little hills, like lambs? #

19_PSA_114_007 Tremble, thou earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob; #

19_PSA_114_008 Which turned the rock [into] a standing water, the flint into a fountain of waters. #

19_PSA_115_001 Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, but unto thy name give glory, for thy mercy, [and] for thy truth's sake. #

19_PSA_115_002 Wherefore should the heathen say, Where [is] now their God? #

19_PSA_115_003 But our God [is] in the heavens, he hath done whatsoever he hath pleased. #

19_PSA_115_004 Their idols [are] silver and gold, the work of men's hands. #

19_PSA_115_005 They have mouths, but they speak not, eyes have they, but they see not, #

19_PSA_115_006 They have ears, but they hear not, noses have they, but they smell not, #

19_PSA_115_007 They have hands, but they handle not, feet have they, but they walk not, neither speak they through their throat. #

19_PSA_115_008 They that make them are like unto them; [so is] every one that trusteth in them. #

19_PSA_115_009 O Israel, trust thou in the LORD, he [is] their help and their shield. #

19_PSA_115_010 O house of Aaron, trust in the LORD, he [is] their help and their shield. #

19_PSA_115_011 Ye that fear the LORD, trust in the LORD, he [is] their help and their shield. #

19_PSA_115_012 The LORD hath been mindful of us, he will bless [us]; he will bless the house of Israel; he will bless the house of Aaron. #

19_PSA_115_013 He will bless them that fear the LORD, [both] small and great. #

19_PSA_115_014 The LORD shall increase you more and more, you and your children. #

19_PSA_115_015 Ye [are] blessed of the LORD which made heaven and earth. #

19_PSA_115_016 The heaven, [even] the heavens, [are] the LORD's, but the earth hath he given to the children of men. #

19_PSA_115_017 The dead praise not the LORD, neither any that go down into silence. #

19_PSA_115_018 But we will bless the LORD from this time forth and for evermore. Praise the LORD. #

19_PSA_116_001 I love the LORD, because he hath heard my voice [and] my supplications. #

19_PSA_116_002 Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore will I call upon [him] as long as I live. #

19_PSA_116_003 The sorrows of death compassed me, and the pains of hell gat hold upon me, I found trouble and sorrow. #

19_PSA_116_006 The LORD preserveth the simple, I was brought low, and he helped me. #

19_PSA_116_007 Return unto thy rest, O my soul; for the LORD hath dealt bountifully with thee. #

19_PSA_116_008 For thou hast delivered my soul from death, mine eyes from tears, [and] my feet from falling. #

19_PSA_116_009 I will walk before the LORD in the land of the living. #

19_PSA_116_010 I believed, therefore have I spoken, I was greatly afflicted, #

19_PSA_116_011 I said in my haste, All men [are] liars. #

19_PSA_116_012 What shall I render unto the LORD [for] all his benefits toward me? #

19_PSA_116_013 I will take the cup of salvation, and call upon the name of the LORD. #

19_PSA_116_014 I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people. #

19_PSA_116_015 Precious in the sight of the LORD [is] the death of his saints. #

19_PSA_116_016 O LORD, truly I [am] thy servant; I [am] thy servant, [and] the son of thine handmaid, thou hast loosed my bonds. #

19_PSA_116_017 I will offer to thee the sacrifice of thanksgiving, and will call upon the name of the LORD. #

19_PSA_116_018 I will pay my vows unto the LORD now in the presence of all his people, #

19_PSA_116_019 In the courts of the LORD's house, in the midst of thee, O Jerusalem. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_117_001 O Praise the LORD, all ye nations, praise him, all ye people. #

19_PSA_118_007 The LORD taketh my part with them that help me, therefore shall I see [my desire] upon them that hate me. #

19_PSA_118_008 [It is] better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in man. #

19_PSA_118_009 [It is] better to trust in the LORD than to put confidence in princes. #

19_PSA_118_010 All nations compassed me about, but in the name of the LORD will I destroy them. #

19_PSA_118_011 They compassed me about; yea, they compassed me about, but in the name of the LORD I will destroy them. #

19_PSA_118_012 They compassed me about like bees; they are quenched as the fire of thorns, for in the name of the LORD I will destroy them. #

19_PSA_118_013 Thou hast thrust sore at me that I might fall, but the LORD helped me. #

19_PSA_118_014 The LORD [is] my strength and song, and is become my salvation. #

19_PSA_118_015 The voice of rejoicing and salvation [is] in the tabernacles of the righteous, the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly. #

19_PSA_118_016 The right hand of the LORD is exalted, the right hand of the LORD doeth valiantly. #

19_PSA_118_017 I shall not die, but live, and declare the works of the LORD. #

19_PSA_118_018 The LORD hath chastened me sore, but he hath not given me over unto death. #

19_PSA_118_019 Open to me the gates of righteousness, I will go into them, [and] I will praise the LORD, #

19_PSA_118_020 This gate of the LORD, into which the righteous shall enter. #

19_PSA_118_021 I will praise thee, for thou hast heard me, and art become my salvation. #

19_PSA_118_022 The stone [which] the builders refused is become the head [stone] of the corner. #

19_PSA_118_023 This is the LORD'S doing; it [is] marvellous in our eyes. #

19_PSA_118_024 This [is] the day [which] the LORD hath made; we will rejoice and be glad in it. #

19_PSA_118_025 Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD, O LORD, I beseech thee, send now prosperity. #

19_PSA_118_026 Blessed [be] he that cometh in the name of the LORD, we have blessed you out of the house of the LORD. #

19_PSA_118_027 God [is] the LORD, which hath showed us light, bind the sacrifice with cords, [even] unto the horns of the altar. #

19_PSA_118_028 Thou [art] my God, and I will praise thee, [thou art] my God, I will exalt thee. #

19_PSA_118_029 O give thanks unto the LORD; for [he is] good, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_119_001 ALEPH. Blessed [are] the undefiled in the way, who walk in the law of the LORD. #

19_PSA_119_007 I will praise thee with uprightness of heart, when I shall have learned thy righteous judgments. #

19_PSA_119_008 I will keep thy statutes, O forsake me not utterly. #

19_PSA_119_009 BETH. Wherewithal shall a young man cleanse his way? by taking heed [thereto] according to thy word. #

19_PSA_119_010 With my whole heart have I sought thee, O let me not wander from thy commandments. #

19_PSA_119_011 Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee. #

19_PSA_119_057 CHETH. [Thou art] my portion, O LORD, I have said that I would keep thy words. #

19_PSA_119_058 I entreated thy favour with [my] whole heart, be merciful unto me according to thy word. #

19_PSA_119_059 I thought on my ways, and turned my feet unto thy testimonies. #

19_PSA_119_060 I made haste, and delayed not to keep thy commandments. #

19_PSA_119_061 The bands of the wicked have robbed me, [but] I have not forgotten thy law. #

19_PSA_119_062 At midnight I will rise to give thanks unto thee because of thy righteous judgments. #

19_PSA_119_075 I know, O LORD, that thy judgments [are] right, and [that] thou in faithfulness hast afflicted me. #

19_PSA_119_124 Deal with thy servant according unto thy mercy, and teach me thy statutes. #

19_PSA_119_125 I [am] thy servant; give me understanding, that I may know thy testimonies. #

kindled against us, #**

**19_PSA_124_004 Then the waters had overwhelmed us, the stream had gone
over our soul, #**

19_PSA_124_005 Then the proud waters had gone over our soul. #

**19_PSA_124_006 Blessed [be] the LORD, who hath not given us [as] a prey to their
teeth. #**

**19_PSA_124_007 Our soul is escaped as a bird out of the snare of the fowlers, the
snare is broken, and we are escaped. #**

19_PSA_124_008 Our help [is] in the name of the LORD, who made heaven and earth. #

19_PSA_125_001 A Song of degrees. They that trust in the LORD [shall be] as mount Zion, [which] cannot be removed, [but] abideth for ever. #

19_PSA_125_002 As the mountains [are] round about Jerusalem, so the LORD [is] round about his people from henceforth even for ever. #

19_PSA_125_003 For the rod of the wicked shall not rest upon the lot of the righteous; lest the righteous put forth their hands unto iniquity. #

19_PSA_125_004 Do good, O LORD, unto [those that be] good, and [to them that are] upright in their hearts. #

19_PSA_126_004 Turn again our captivity, O LORD, as the streams in the south. #

19_PSA_127_001 A Song of degrees for Solomon. Except the LORD build the house, they labour in vain that build it, except the LORD keep the city, the watchman waketh [but] in vain. #

19_PSA_127_002 [It is] vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows, [for] so he giveth his beloved sleep. #

19_PSA_127_003 Lo, children [are] an heritage of the LORD, [and] the fruit of the womb [is his] reward. #

19_PSA_127_004 As arrows [are] in the hand of a mighty man; so [are] children of the youth. #

19_PSA_127_005 Happy [is] the man that hath his quiver full of them, they shall not be ashamed, but they shall speak with the enemies in the gate. #

19_PSA_128_001 A Song of degrees. Blessed [is] every one that feareth the LORD; that walketh in his ways. #

19_PSA_128_002 For thou shalt eat the labour of thine hands, happy [shalt] thou [be], and [it shall be] well with thee. #

19_PSA_128_003 Thy wife [shall be] as a fruitful vine by the sides of thine house, thy children like olive plants round about thy table. #

19_PSA_128_004 Behold, that thus shall the man be blessed that feareth the LORD. #

19_PSA_129_007 Wherewith the mower filleth not his hand; nor he that bindeth sheaves his bosom. #

19_PSA_129_008 Neither do they which go by say, The blessing of the LORD [be] upon you, we bless you in the name of the LORD. #

19_PSA_130_001 A Song of degrees. Out of the depths have I cried unto thee, O LORD. #

19_PSA_130_002 Lord, hear my voice, let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications. #

19_PSA_130_003 If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand? #

19_PSA_130_004 But [there is] forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared. #

19_PSA_130_005 I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope. #

19_PSA_130_006 My soul [waiteth] for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning, [I say, more than] they that watch for the morning. #

19_PSA_130_007 Let Israel hope in the LORD, for with the LORD [there is] mercy, and with him [is] plenteous redemption. #

19_PSA_130_008 And he shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities. #

19_PSA_131_001 A Song of degrees of David. LORD, my heart is not haughty, nor mine eyes lofty, neither do I exercise myself in great matters, or in things too high for me. #

19_PSA_131_002 Surely I have behaved and quieted myself, as a child that is weaned of his mother, my soul [is] even as a weaned child. #

19_PSA_131_003 Let Israel hope in the LORD from henceforth and for ever. #

19_PSA_132_001 A Song of degrees. LORD, remember David, [and] all his afflictions, #

19_PSA_132_002 How he swore unto the LORD, [and] vowed unto the mighty [God] of Jacob; #

19_PSA_132_003 Surely I will not come into the tabernacle of my house, nor go up into my bed; #

19_PSA_132_004 I will not give sleep to mine eyes, [or] slumber to mine eyelids, #

19_PSA_132_006 Lo, we heard of it at Ephratah, we found it in the fields of the wood. #

19_PSA_132_007 We will go into his tabernacles, we will worship at his footstool. #

19_PSA_132_008 Arise, O LORD, into thy rest; thou, and the ark of thy strength. #

19_PSA_132_009 Let thy priests be clothed with righteousness; and let thy saints shout for joy. #

19_PSA_132_010 For thy servant David's sake turn not away the face of thine anointed. #

19_PSA_132_011 The LORD hath sworn [in] truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne. #

19_PSA_132_012 If thy children will keep my covenant and my testimony that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy throne for evermore. #

19_PSA_132_013 For the LORD hath chosen Zion; he hath desired [it] for his habitation. #

19_PSA_132_014 This [is] my rest for ever, here will I dwell; for I have desired it. #

19_PSA_132_015 I will abundantly bless her provision, I will satisfy her poor with bread. #

19_PSA_132_016 I will also clothe her priests with salvation, and her saints shall shout aloud for joy. #

19_PSA_132_017 There will I make the horn of David to bud, I have ordained a lamp for mine anointed. #

19_PSA_132_018 His enemies will I clothe with shame, but upon himself shall his crown flourish. #

19_PSA_133_001 A Song of degrees of David. Behold, how good and how pleasant [it is] for brethren to dwell together in unity! #

19_PSA_133_002 [It is] like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, [even] Aaron's beard, that went down to the skirts of his garments; #

19_PSA_133_003 As the dew of Hermon, [and as the dew] that descended upon the mountains of Zion, for there the LORD commanded the blessing, [even] life for evermore. #

19_PSA_134_001 A Song of degrees. Behold, bless ye the LORD, all [ye] servants of the LORD, which by night stand in the house of the LORD. #

19_PSA_134_002 Lift up your hands [in] the sanctuary, and bless the LORD. #

19_PSA_135_008 Who smote the firstborn of Egypt, both of man and beast. #

19_PSA_135_009 [Who] sent tokens and wonders into the midst of thee, O Egypt, upon Pharaoh, and upon all his servants. #

19_PSA_135_010 Who smote great nations, and slew mighty kings; #

19_PSA_135_011 Sihon king of the Amorites, and Og king of Bashan, and all the kingdoms of Canaan, #

19_PSA_135_012 And gave their land [for] an heritage, an heritage unto Israel his people. #

19_PSA_135_013 Thy name, O LORD, [endureth] for ever; [and] thy memorial, O LORD, throughout all generations. #

19_PSA_135_014 For the LORD will judge his people, and he will repent himself concerning his servants. #

19_PSA_135_015 The idols of the heathen [are] silver and gold, the work of men's hands. #

19_PSA_135_016 They have mouths, but they speak not; eyes have they, but they see not; #

19_PSA_135_017 They have ears, but they hear not; neither is there [any] breath in their mouths. #

19_PSA_135_018 They that make them are like unto them, [so is] every one that trusteth in them. #

19_PSA_135_019 Bless the LORD, O house of Israel, bless the LORD, O house of Aaron, #

19_PSA_135_020 Bless the LORD, O house of Levi, ye that fear the LORD, bless the LORD. #

19_PSA_135_021 Blessed be the LORD out of Zion, which dwelleth at Jerusalem. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_136_001 O give thanks unto the LORD; for [he is] good, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_002 O give thanks unto the God of gods, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_003 O give thanks to the Lord of lords, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_004 To him who alone doeth great wonders, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_005 To him that by wisdom made the heavens, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_006 To him that stretched out the earth above the waters, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_007 To him that made great lights, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_008 The sun to rule by day, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_009 The moon and stars to rule by night, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_010 To him that smote Egypt in their firstborn, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_011 And brought out Israel from among them, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_012 With a strong hand, and with a stretched out arm, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_013 To him which divided the Red sea into parts, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_014 And made Israel to pass through the midst of it, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_015 But overthrew Pharaoh and his host in the Red sea, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_016 To him which led his people through the wilderness, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_017 To him which smote great kings, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_018 And slew famous kings, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_019 Sihon king of the Amorites, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_020 And Og the king of Bashan, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_021 And gave their land for an heritage, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_022 [Even] an heritage unto Israel his servant, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_023 Who remembered us in our low estate, for his mercy [endureth] for ever, #

19_PSA_136_024 And hath redeemed us from our enemies, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_025 Who giveth food to all flesh, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_136_026 O give thanks unto the God of heaven, for his mercy [endureth] for ever. #

19_PSA_137_001 By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down, yea, we wept, when we remembered Zion. #

19_PSA_137_002 We hanged our harps upon the willows in the midst thereof. #

19_PSA_137_003 For there they that carried us away captive required of us a song; and they that wasted us [required of us] mirth, [saying], Sing us [one] of the

songs of Zion. #

19_PSA_137_004 How shall we sing the LORD's song in a strange land? #

19_PSA_137_005 If I forget thee, O Jerusalem, let my right hand forget [her cunning]. #

19_PSA_137_006 If I do not remember thee, let my tongue cleave to the roof of my mouth; if I prefer not Jerusalem above my chief joy. #

19_PSA_137_007 Remember, O LORD, the children of Edom in the day of Jerusalem; who said, Raze [it], raze [it, even] to the foundation thereof. #

19_PSA_137_008 O daughter of Babylon, who art to be destroyed; happy [shall he be], that rewardeth thee as thou hast served us. #

19_PSA_137_009 Happy [shall he be], that taketh and dasheth thy little ones against the stones. #

19_PSA_138_001 [A Psalm] of David. I will praise thee with my whole heart, before the gods will I sing praise unto thee. #

19_PSA_138_002 I will worship toward thy holy temple, and praise thy name for thy lovingkindness and for thy truth, for thou hast magnified thy word above all thy name. #

19_PSA_138_003 In the day when I cried thou answeredst me, [and] strengthenedst me [with] strength in my soul. #

19_PSA_138_004 All the kings of the earth shall praise thee, O LORD, when they hear the words of thy mouth. #

19_PSA_138_005 Yea, they shall sing in the ways of the LORD, for great [is] the glory of the LORD. #

19_PSA_138_006 Though the LORD [be] high, yet hath he respect unto the lowly, but the proud he knoweth afar off. #

19_PSA_138_007 Though I walk in the midst of trouble, thou wilt revive me, thou shalt stretch forth thine hand against the wrath of mine enemies, and thy right hand shall save me. #

19_PSA_138_008 The LORD will perfect [that which] concerneth me, thy mercy, O LORD, [endureth] for ever, forsake not the works of thine own hands. #

19_PSA_139_001 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. O LORD, thou hast searched me, and known [me]. #

19_PSA_139_002 Thou knowest my downsitting and mine uprising, thou understandest my thought afar off. #

19_PSA_139_003 Thou compassest my path and my lying down, and art acquainted [with] all my ways. #

19_PSA_139_004 For [there is] not a word in my tongue, [but], lo, O LORD, thou knowest it altogether. #

19_PSA_139_005 Thou hast beset me behind and before, and laid thine hand upon me. #

19_PSA_139_006 [Such] knowledge [is] too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot [attain] unto it. #

19_PSA_139_007 Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence? #

19_PSA_139_008 If I ascend up into heaven, thou [art] there, if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou [art there]. #

19_PSA_139_009 [If] I take the wings of the morning, [and] dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; #

19_PSA_139_010 Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me. #

19_PSA_139_011 If I say, Surely the darkness shall cover me; even the night shall be light about me. #

19_PSA_139_012 Yea, the darkness hideth not from thee; but the night shineth as the day, the darkness and the light [are] both alike [to thee]. #

19_PSA_139_013 For thou hast possessed my reins, thou hast covered me in my mother's womb. #

19_PSA_139_014 I will praise thee; for I am fearfully [and] wonderfully made, marvellous [are] thy works; and [that] my soul knoweth right well. #

19_PSA_139_015 My substance was not hid from thee, when I was made in secret, [and] curiously wrought in the lowest parts of the earth. #

19_PSA_139_016 Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all [my members] were written, [which] in continuance were fashioned, when [as yet there was] none of them. #

19_PSA_139_017 How precious also are thy thoughts unto me, O God! how great is the sum of them! #

19_PSA_139_018 [If] I should count them, they are more in number than the sand, when I awake, I am still with thee. #

19_PSA_139_019 Surely thou wilt slay the wicked, O God, depart from me therefore, ye bloody men. #

19_PSA_139_020 For they speak against thee wickedly, [and] thine enemies take [thy name] in vain. #

19_PSA_139_021 Do not I hate them, O LORD, that hate thee? and am not I grieved with those that rise up against thee? #

19_PSA_139_022 I hate them with perfect hatred, I count them mine enemies. #

19_PSA_139_023 Search me, O God, and know my heart, try me, and know my thoughts, #

19_PSA_139_024 And see if [there be any] wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting. #

19_PSA_140_001 To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man, preserve me from the violent man; #

19_PSA_140_002 Which imagine mischiefs in [their] heart; continually are they gathered together [for] war. #

19_PSA_140_003 They have sharpened their tongues like a serpent; adders' poison [is] under their lips. Selah. #

19_PSA_140_004 Keep me, O LORD, from the hands of the wicked; preserve me from the violent man; who have purposed to overthrow my goings. #

19_PSA_140_005 The proud have hid a snare for me, and cords; they have spread a net by the wayside; they have set gins for me. Selah. #

19_PSA_140_006 I said unto the LORD, Thou [art] my God, hear the voice of my supplications, O LORD. #

19_PSA_140_007 O GOD the Lord, the strength of my salvation, thou hast covered my head in the day of battle. #

19_PSA_140_008 Grant not, O LORD, the desires of the wicked, further not his wicked device; [lest] they exalt themselves. Selah. #

19_PSA_140_009 [As for] the head of those that compass me about, let the mischief of their own lips cover them. #

19_PSA_140_010 Let burning coals fall upon them, let them be cast into the fire; into deep pits, that they rise not up again. #

19_PSA_140_011 Let not an evil speaker be established in the earth, evil shall hunt the violent man to overthrow [him]. #

19_PSA_140_012 I know that the LORD will maintain the cause of the afflicted, [and] the right of the poor. #

19_PSA_140_013 Surely the righteous shall give thanks unto thy name, the upright shall dwell in thy presence. #

19_PSA_141_001 A Psalm of David. LORD, I cry unto thee, make haste unto me; give ear unto my voice, when I cry unto thee. #

19_PSA_141_002 Let my prayer be set forth before thee [as] incense; [and] the lifting up of my hands [as] the evening sacrifice. #

19_PSA_141_003 Set a watch, O LORD, before my mouth; keep the door of my lips. #

19_PSA_141_004 Incline not my heart to [any] evil thing, to practice wicked works with men that work iniquity, and let me not eat of their dainties. #

19_PSA_141_005 Let the righteous smite me; [it shall be] a kindness, and let him reprove me; [it shall be] an excellent oil, [which] shall not break my head, for yet my prayer also [shall be] in their calamities. #

19_PSA_141_006 When their judges are overthrown in stony places, they shall hear my words; for they are sweet. #

19_PSA_141_007 Our bones are scattered at the grave's mouth, as when one cutteth and cleaveth [wood] upon the earth. #

19_PSA_141_008 But mine eyes [are] unto thee, O GOD the Lord, in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute. #

19_PSA_141_009 Keep me from the snares [which] they have laid for me, and the gins of the workers of iniquity. #

19_PSA_141_010 Let the wicked fall into their own nets, whilst that I withal escape. #

19_PSA_142_001 Maschil of David; A Prayer when he was in the cave. I cried unto the LORD with my voice; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my supplication. #

19_PSA_142_002 I poured out my complaint before him; I showed before him my trouble. #

19_PSA_142_003 When my spirit was overwhelmed within me, then thou knewest my path. In the way wherein I walked have they privily laid a snare for me. #

19_PSA_142_004 I looked on [my] right hand, and beheld, but [there was] no man that would know me, refuge failed me; no man cared for my soul. #

19_PSA_142_005 I cried unto thee, O LORD, I said, Thou [art] my refuge [and] my portion in the land of the living. #

19_PSA_142_006 Attend unto my cry; for I am brought very low, deliver me from my persecutors; for they are stronger than I. #

19_PSA_142_007 Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise thy name, the righteous shall compass me about; for thou shalt deal bountifully with me. #

19_PSA_143_001 A Psalm of David. Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications, in thy faithfulness answer me, [and] in thy righteousness. #

19_PSA_143_002 And enter not into judgment with thy servant, for in thy sight shall no man living be justified. #

19_PSA_143_003 For the enemy hath persecuted my soul; he hath smitten my life down to the ground; he hath made me to dwell in darkness, as those that have been long dead. #

19_PSA_143_004 Therefore is my spirit overwhelmed within me; my heart within me is desolate. #

19_PSA_143_005 I remember the days of old; I meditate on all thy works; I muse on the work of thy hands. #

19_PSA_143_006 I stretch forth my hands unto thee, my soul [thirsteth] after thee, as a thirsty land. Selah. #

19_PSA_143_007 Hear me speedily, O LORD, my spirit faileth, hide not thy face from me, lest I be like unto them that go down into the pit. #

19_PSA_143_008 Cause me to hear thy lovingkindness in the morning; for in thee do I trust, cause me to know the way wherein I should walk; for I lift up my soul unto thee. #

19_PSA_143_009 Deliver me, O LORD, from mine enemies, I flee unto thee to hide me. #

19_PSA_143_010 Teach me to do thy will; for thou [art] my God, thy spirit [is] good; lead me into the land of uprightness. #

19_PSA_143_011 Quicken me, O LORD, for thy name's sake, for thy righteousness' sake bring my soul out of trouble. #

19_PSA_143_012 And of thy mercy cut off mine enemies, and destroy all them that afflict my soul, for I [am] thy servant. #

19_PSA_144_001 [A Psalm] of David. Blessed [be] the LORD my strength, which teacheth my hands to war, [and] my fingers to fight, #

19_PSA_144_002 My goodness, and my fortress; my high tower, and my deliverer; my shield, and [he] in whom I trust; who subdueth my people under me. #

19_PSA_144_003 LORD, what [is] man, that thou takest knowledge of him! [or] the son of man, that thou makest account of him! #

19_PSA_144_004 Man is like to vanity, his days [are] as a shadow that passeth away. #

19_PSA_144_005 Bow thy heavens, O LORD, and come down, touch the mountains, and they shall smoke. #

19_PSA_144_006 Cast forth lightning, and scatter them, shoot out thine arrows, and destroy them. #

19_PSA_144_007 Send thine hand from above; rid me, and deliver me out of great waters, from the hand of strange children; #

19_PSA_144_008 Whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand [is] a right hand of falsehood. #

19_PSA_144_009 I will sing a new song unto thee, O God, upon a psaltery [and] an instrument of ten strings will I sing praises unto thee. #

19_PSA_144_010 [It is he] that giveth salvation unto kings, who delivereth David his servant from the hurtful sword. #

19_PSA_144_011 Rid me, and deliver me from the hand of strange children, whose mouth speaketh vanity, and their right hand [is] a right hand of falsehood, #

19_PSA_144_012 That our sons [may be] as plants grown up in their youth; [that] our daughters [may be] as corner stones, polished [after] the similitude of a palace, #

19_PSA_144_013 [That] our garners [may be] full, affording all manner of store, [that] our sheep may bring forth thousands and ten thousands in our streets, #

19_PSA_144_014 [That] our oxen [may be] strong to labour; [that there be] no breaking in, nor going out; that [there be] no complaining in our streets. #

19_PSA_144_015 Happy [is that] people, that is in such a case, [yea], happy [is that] people, whose God [is] the LORD. #

19_PSA_145_001 David's [Psalm] of praise. I will extol thee, my God, O king; and I will bless thy name for ever and ever. #

19_PSA_145_002 Every day will I bless thee; and I will praise thy name for ever and ever. #

19_PSA_145_003 Great [is] the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and his greatness [is] unsearchable. #

19_PSA_145_004 One generation shall praise thy works to another, and shall declare thy mighty acts. #

19_PSA_145_005 I will speak of the glorious honour of thy majesty, and of thy wondrous works. #

19_PSA_145_006 And [men] shall speak of the might of thy terrible acts, and I will declare thy greatness. #

19_PSA_145_007 They shall abundantly utter the memory of thy great goodness, and shall sing of thy righteousness. #

19_PSA_145_008 The LORD [is] gracious, and full of compassion; slow to anger, and of great mercy. #

19_PSA_145_009 The LORD [is] good to all, and his tender mercies [are] over all his works. #

19_PSA_145_010 All thy works shall praise thee, O LORD; and thy saints shall bless thee. #

19_PSA_145_011 They shall speak of the glory of thy kingdom, and talk of thy power; #

19_PSA_145_012 To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of his kingdom. #

19_PSA_145_013 Thy kingdom [is] an everlasting kingdom, and thy dominion [endureth] throughout all generations. #

19_PSA_145_014 The LORD upholdeth all that fall, and raiseth up all [those that be] bowed down. #

19_PSA_145_015 The eyes of all wait upon thee; and thou givest them their meat in due season. #

19_PSA_145_016 Thou openest thine hand, and satisfiest the desire of every living thing. #

19_PSA_145_017 The LORD [is] righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works. #

19_PSA_145_018 The LORD [is] nigh unto all them that call upon him, to all that call upon him in truth. #

19_PSA_145_019 He will fulfil the desire of them that fear him, he also will hear their cry, and will save them. #

19_PSA_145_020 The LORD preserveth all them that love him, but all the wicked will he destroy. #

19_PSA_145_021 My mouth shall speak the praise of the LORD, and let all flesh bless his holy name for ever and ever. #

19_PSA_146_001 Praise ye the LORD. Praise the LORD, O my soul. #

19_PSA_146_002 While I live will I praise the LORD, I will sing praises unto my God while I have any being. #

19_PSA_146_003 Put not your trust in princes, [nor] in the son of man, in whom [there is] no help. #

19_PSA_146_004 His breath goeth forth, he returneth to his earth; in that very day his thoughts perish. #

19_PSA_146_005 Happy [is he] that [hath] the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope [is] in the LORD his God, #

19_PSA_146_006 Which made heaven, and earth, the sea, and all that therein [is], which keepeth truth for ever, #

19_PSA_146_007 Which executeth judgment for the oppressed, which giveth food to the hungry. The LORD looseth the prisoners, #

19_PSA_146_008 The LORD openeth [the eyes of] the blind, the LORD raiseth them that are bowed down, the LORD loveth the righteous, #

19_PSA_146_009 The LORD preserveth the strangers; he relieveth the fatherless and widow, but the way of the wicked he turneth upside down. #

19_PSA_146_010 The LORD shall reign for ever, [even] thy God, O Zion, unto all generations. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_147_001 Praise ye the LORD, for [it is] good to sing praises unto our God; for [it is] pleasant; [and] praise is comely. #

19_PSA_147_002 The LORD doth build up Jerusalem, he gathereth together the outcasts of Israel. #

19_PSA_147_003 He healeth the broken in heart, and bindeth up their wounds. #

19_PSA_147_004 He telleth the number of the stars; he calleth them all by [their] names. #

19_PSA_147_005 Great [is] our Lord, and of great power, his understanding [is] infinite. #

19_PSA_147_006 The LORD lifteth up the meek, he casteth the wicked down to the ground. #

19_PSA_147_007 Sing unto the LORD with thanksgiving; sing praise upon the harp unto our God, #

19_PSA_147_008 Who covereth the heaven with clouds, who prepareth rain for the earth, who maketh grass to grow upon the mountains. #

19_PSA_147_009 He giveth to the beast his food, [and] to the young ravens which cry. #

19_PSA_147_010 He delighteth not in the strength of the horse, he taketh not pleasure in the legs of a man. #

19_PSA_147_011 The LORD taketh pleasure in them that fear him, in those that hope in his mercy. #

19_PSA_147_012 Praise the LORD, O Jerusalem; praise thy God, O Zion. #

19_PSA_147_013 For he hath strengthened the bars of thy gates; he hath blessed thy children within thee. #

19_PSA_147_014 He maketh peace [in] thy borders, [and] filleth thee with the finest of the wheat. #

19_PSA_147_015 He sendeth forth his commandment [upon] earth, his word runneth very swiftly. #

19_PSA_147_016 He giveth snow like wool, he scattereth the hoarfrost like ashes. #

19_PSA_147_017 He casteth forth his ice like morsels, who can stand before his cold? #

19_PSA_147_018 He sendeth out his word, and melteth them, he causeth his wind to blow, [and] the waters flow. #

19_PSA_147_019 He showeth his word unto Jacob, his statutes and his judgments unto Israel. #

19_PSA_147_020 He hath not dealt so with any nation, and [as for his] judgments, they have not known them. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_148_001 Praise ye the LORD. Praise ye the LORD from the heavens, praise him in the heights. #

19_PSA_148_002 Praise ye him, all his angels, praise ye him, all his hosts. #

19_PSA_148_003 Praise ye him, sun and moon, praise him, all ye stars of light. #

19_PSA_148_004 Praise him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that [be] above the heavens. #

19_PSA_148_005 Let them praise the name of the LORD, for he commanded, and they were created. #

19_PSA_148_006 He hath also stablished them for ever and ever, he hath made a decree which shall not pass. #

19_PSA_148_007 Praise the LORD from the earth, ye dragons, and all deeps, #

19_PSA_148_008 Fire, and hail; snow, and vapours; stormy wind fulfilling his word, #

19_PSA_148_009 Mountains, and all hills; fruitful trees, and all cedars, #

19_PSA_148_010 Beasts, and all cattle; creeping things, and flying fowl, #

19_PSA_148_011 Kings of the earth, and all people; princes, and all judges of the earth, #

19_PSA_148_012 Both young men, and maidens; old men, and children, #

19_PSA_148_013 Let them praise the name of the LORD, for his name alone is excellent; his glory [is] above the earth and heaven. #

19_PSA_148_014 He also exalteth the horn of his people, the praise of all his saints; [even] of the children of Israel, a people near unto him. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_149_001 Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, [and] his praise in the congregation of saints. #

19_PSA_149_002 Let Israel rejoice in him that made him, let the children of Zion be joyful in their King. #

19_PSA_149_003 Let them praise his name in the dance, let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp. #

19_PSA_149_004 For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people, he will beautify the meek with salvation. #

19_PSA_149_005 Let the saints be joyful in glory, let them sing aloud upon their beds. #

19_PSA_149_006 [Let] the high [praises] of God [be] in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand; #

19_PSA_149_007 To execute vengeance upon the heathen, [and] punishments upon the people; #

19_PSA_149_008 To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron; #

19_PSA_149_009 To execute upon them the judgment written, this honour have all his saints. Praise ye the LORD. #

19_PSA_150_001 Praise ye the LORD. Praise God in his sanctuary, praise him in the firmament of his power. #

19_PSA_150_002 Praise him for his mighty acts, praise him according to his excellent greatness. #

19_PSA_150_003 Praise him with the sound of the trumpet, praise him with the psaltery and harp. #

19_PSA_150_004 Praise him with the timbrel and dance, praise him with stringed instruments and organs. #

19_PSA_150_005 Praise him upon the loud cymbals, praise him upon the high sounding cymbals. #

19_PSA_150_006 Let every thing that hath breath praise the LORD. Praise ye the LORD. #

20_PRO_01_01 The proverbs of Solomon the son of David, king of Israel; #

20_PRO_01_02 To know wisdom and instruction; to perceive the words of understanding; #

20_PRO_01_03 To receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, and judgment, and equity; #

20_PRO_01_04 To give subtlety to the simple, to the young man knowledge and discretion. #

20_PRO_01_05 A wise [man] will hear, and will increase learning; and a man of understanding shall attain unto wise counsels, #

20_PRO_01_06 To understand a proverb, and the interpretation; the words of the wise, and their dark sayings. #

20_PRO_01_07 The fear of the LORD [is] the beginning of knowledge, [but] fools despise wisdom and instruction. #

20_PRO_01_08 My son, hear the instruction of thy father, and forsake not the law of thy mother, #

20_PRO_01_09 For they [shall be] an ornament of grace unto thy head, and chains about thy neck. #

20_PRO_01_10 My son, if sinners entice thee, consent thou not. #

20_PRO_01_11 If they say, Come with us, let us lay wait for blood, let us lurk privily for the innocent without cause, #

20_PRO_01_12 Let us swallow them up alive as the grave; and whole, as those that go down into the pit, #

20_PRO_01_13 We shall find all precious substance, we shall fill our houses with spoil, #

20_PRO_01_14 Cast in thy lot among us; let us all have one purse, #

20_PRO_01_15 My son, walk not thou in the way with them; refrain thy foot from their path, #

20_PRO_01_16 For their feet run to evil, and make haste to shed blood. #

20_PRO_01_17 Surely in vain the net is spread in the sight of any bird. #

20_PRO_01_18 And they lay wait for their [own] blood; they lurk privily for their [own] lives. #

20_PRO_01_19 So [are] the ways of every one that is greedy of gain; [which] taketh away the life of the owners thereof. #

20_PRO_01_20 Wisdom crieth without; she uttereth her voice in the streets, #

20_PRO_01_21 She crieth in the chief place of concourse, in the openings of the gates, in the city she uttereth her words, [saying], #

20_PRO_01_22 How long, ye simple ones, will ye love simplicity? and the scorers delight in their scorning, and fools hate knowledge? #

20_PRO_01_23 Turn you at my reproof, behold, I will pour out my spirit unto you, I will make known my words unto you. #

20_PRO_01_24 Because I have called, and ye refused; I have stretched out my hand, and no man regarded; #

20_PRO_01_25 But ye have set at nought all my counsel, and would none of my reproof, #

20_PRO_01_26 I also will laugh at your calamity; I will mock when your fear cometh; #

20_PRO_01_27 When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you. #

20_PRO_01_28 Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me, #

20_PRO_01_29 For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD, #

20_PRO_01_30 They would none of my counsel, they despised all my reproof. #

20_PRO_01_31 Therefore shall they eat of the fruit of their own way, and be filled with their own devices. #

20_PRO_01_32 For the turning away of the simple shall slay them, and the prosperity of fools shall destroy them. #

20_PRO_01_33 But whoso hearkeneth unto me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil. #

20_PRO_02_01 My son, if thou wilt receive my words, and hide my commandments with thee; #

20_PRO_02_02 So that thou incline thine ear unto wisdom, [and] apply thine heart to understanding; #

20_PRO_02_03 Yea, if thou criest after knowledge, [and] liftest up thy voice for understanding; #

20_PRO_02_04 If thou seekest her as silver, and searchest for her as [for] hid treasures; #

20_PRO_02_05 Then shalt thou understand the fear of the LORD, and find the knowledge of God. #

20_PRO_02_06 For the LORD giveth wisdom, out of his mouth [cometh] knowledge and understanding. #

20_PRO_02_07 He layeth up sound wisdom for the righteous, [he is] a buckler to them that walk uprightly. #

20_PRO_02_08 He keepeth the paths of judgment, and preserveth the way of his saints. #

20_PRO_02_09 Then shalt thou understand righteousness, and judgment, and equity; [yea], every good path. #

20_PRO_02_10 When wisdom entereth into thine heart, and knowledge is pleasant unto thy soul; #

20_PRO_02_11 Discretion shall preserve thee, understanding shall keep thee, #

20_PRO_02_12 To deliver thee from the way of the evil [man], from the man that speaketh froward things; #

20_PRO_02_13 Who leave the paths of uprightness, to walk in the ways of darkness; #

20_PRO_02_14 Who rejoice to do evil, [and] delight in the frowardness of the wicked; #

20_PRO_02_15 Whose ways [are] crooked, and [they] froward in their paths, #

20_PRO_02_16 To deliver thee from the strange woman, [even] from the stranger [which] flattereth with her words; #

20_PRO_02_17 Which forsaketh the guide of her youth, and forgetteth the covenant of her God. #

20_PRO_02_18 For her house inclineth unto death, and her paths unto the dead. #

20_PRO_02_19 None that go unto her return again, neither take they hold of the paths of life. #

20_PRO_02_20 That thou mayest walk in the way of good [men], and keep the paths of the righteous. #

20_PRO_02_21 For the upright shall dwell in the land, and the perfect shall remain in it. #

20_PRO_02_22 But the wicked shall be cut off from the earth, and the transgressors shall be rooted out of it. #

20_PRO_03_01 My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments, #

20_PRO_03_02 For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee. #

20_PRO_03_03 Let not mercy and truth forsake thee, bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart, #

20_PRO_03_04 So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man. #

20_PRO_03_05 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. #

20_PRO_03_06 In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths. #

20_PRO_03_07 Be not wise in thine own eyes, fear the LORD, and depart from evil. #

20_PRO_03_08 It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones. #

20_PRO_03_09 Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase, #

20_PRO_03_10 So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine. #

20_PRO_03_11 My son, despise not the chastening of the LORD; neither be weary of his correction, #

20_PRO_03_12 For whom the LORD loveth he correcteth; even as a father the son [in whom] he delighteth. #

20_PRO_03_13 Happy [is] the man [that] findeth wisdom, and the man [that] getteth understanding. #

20_PRO_03_14 For the merchandise of it [is] better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold. #
